## Wednesday, October 8th



- Those without a faith tradition who are looking for a spiritual home



#### WALKING WITH MOMS IN NEED

Walking with Moms in Need is a nationwide parish-based initiative to increase support for pregnant and parenting mothers in need. The program currently has four areas of focus here at St. Peter:

- 1. Maintaining and sharing a list of local resources that are available to moms in need
- 2. Walking alongside moms offering peer support, companionship, and authentic Christian friendship throughout the motherhood journey
- 3. Providing material assistance in the form of basic baby/toddler items
- 4. Educating parishioners about what we offer, so everyone can refer moms in need to us




