The U.S. bishops have chosen the theme **"Life: Our Sign of Hope"** for 2025–2026, marking the Church's Jubilee Year of Hope. Every human life is a sign of God's promise, a witness to His love, and a reason for us to hope.

Bishop Daniel E. Thomas reminds us:

"This Jubilee Year we are challenged to be agents of hope to those whose hearts are burdened by trial, difficulty, or suffering, offering them the hope that comes from Christ Jesus alone."

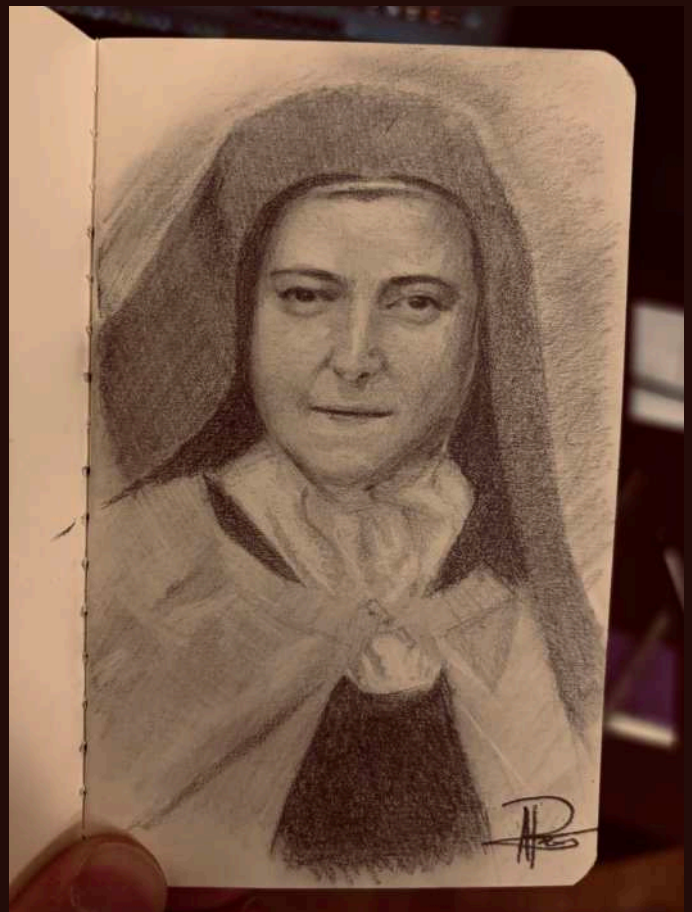
THÉRÈSE

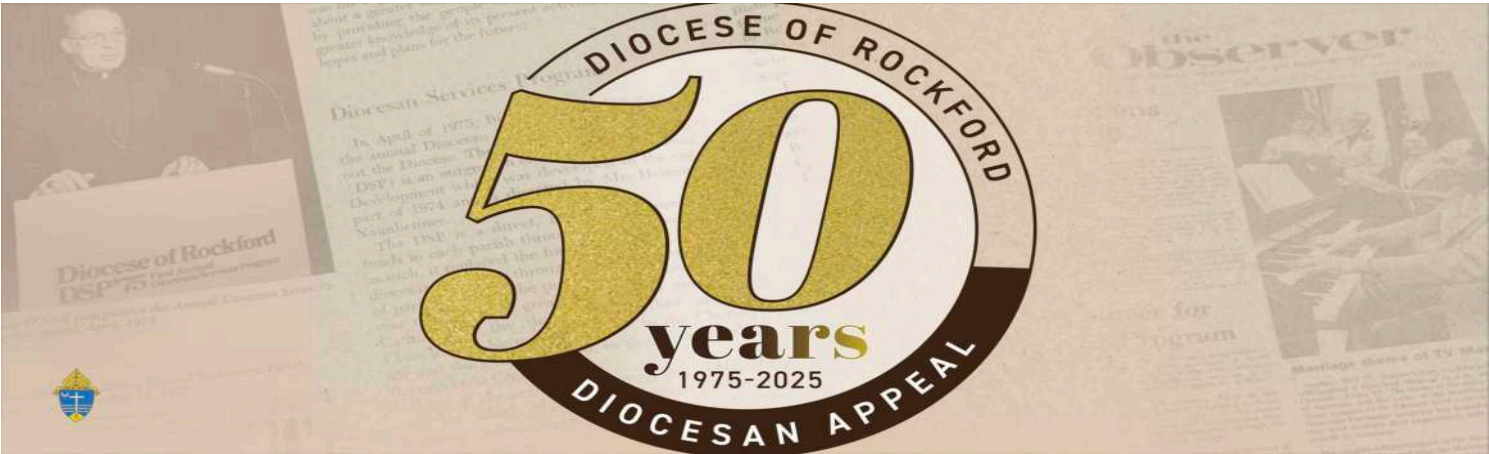

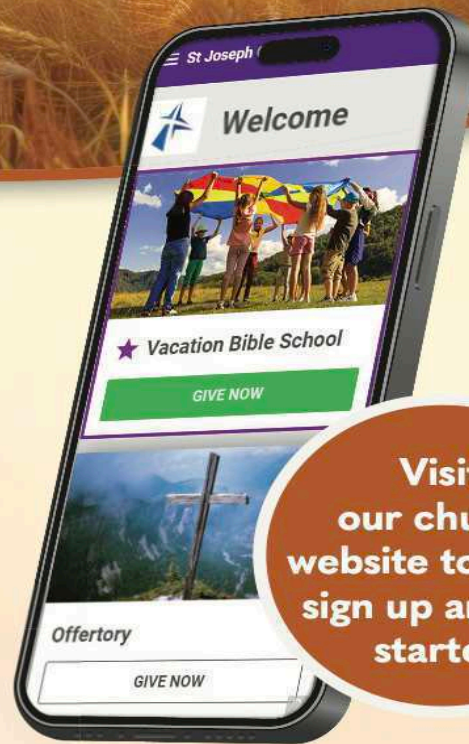

Wednesday, October 8th

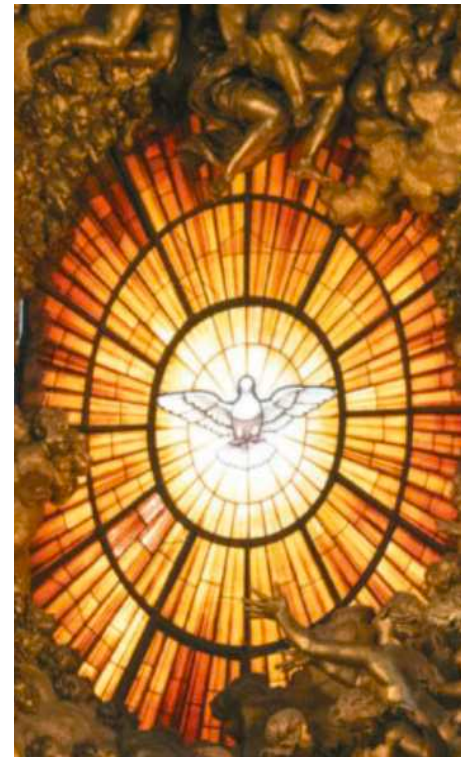

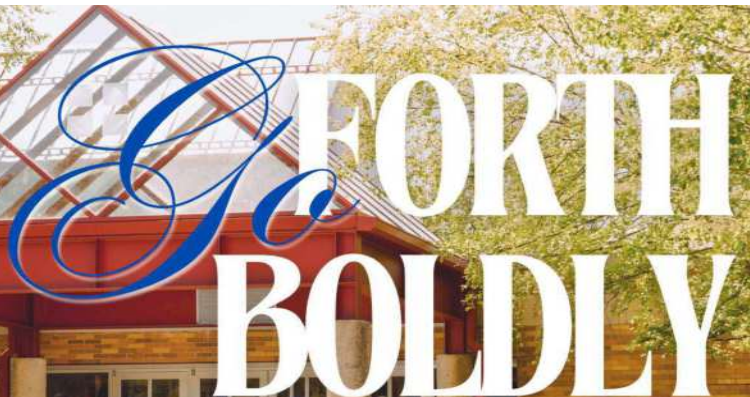

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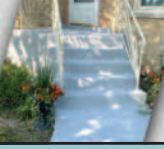
