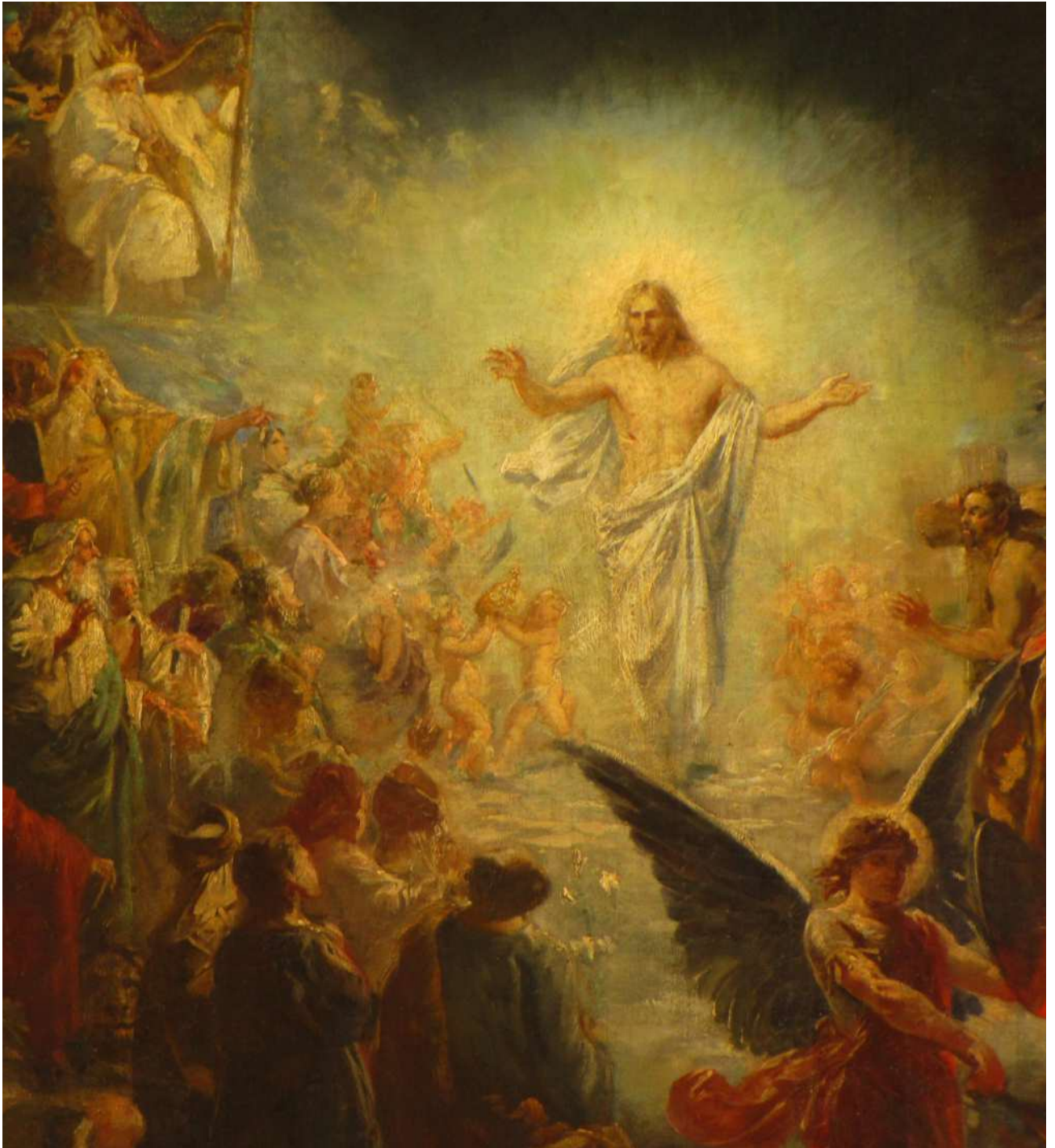

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

"Pray Always and Do Not Lose Heart" – Luke 18:1-8

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the persistent widow who refuses to give up. Day after day, she pleads with an unjust judge for justice. At first, he ignores her—but eventually he gives in, not because he is good or compassionate, but because she refuses to quit.

Jesus uses this surprising story to teach us something essential about prayer: persistence matters. If even an unjust judge eventually listens, how much more will our loving Father hear us when we cry out to Him?

We often think prayer should bring instant results, but Jesus reminds us that prayer is not magic—it is a relationship. God uses prayer to shape our hearts, deepen our trust, and draw us close to Him. Sometimes the apparent "silence" of God is actually an invitation to press in more deeply, to surrender more fully, and to persevere with faith.

The widow in the parable had no earthly power or influence—yet her persistence moved the judge to act. Likewise, we may feel weak or overwhelmed by life's challenges, but persevering prayer unleashes heavenly grace.

Jesus ends with a challenging question:
"When the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

Faith is not just believing that God exists—it is trusting Him enough to keep praying even when we don't see results right away. It is refusing to give up on God because we know He never gives up on us.

So keep praying.
When you are tired—pray.
When you are discouraged—pray.
When answers seem delayed—pray.
God hears. God remembers. God will act in His perfect time.

Let us be people of persistent prayer and unshakable faith.

A TUTORIAL OF SORTS

I wanted to peel back the curtain a little bit and bring you all through a step-by-step of sorts of my process when drawing. For this example, I recently did a small drawing of Jonathan Roumie's Jesus.

Step 1: Block In. This is one of the most important steps because it lays the foundation on which everything else is built upon. Here, I just use simple lines and shapes to establish proportions. I am not worrying about details yet.

Step 2: Features. Now I start laying down the basic features of the face. I am primarily just focusing on getting everything in the right place and in the right relationship to each other, since that is where the likeness will be.

Step 3: Values: At this point I start building the basic values of this image. I am, again, still trying to keep it simple and not go overboard. I want to establish where the dark areas and dominant shadows are.

Step 4: Smear Campaign. I now, use a tissue or blending stick to blend a consistent tone across the entire face. Not so much that I lose all the features and shadows I worked so hard to establish. But enough to where the graphite can work into all the grit of the paper and give me a good base to start building the details.

Step 5: Finish. I start building back some of the sharpness that was lost by the blending as well as locking in the darkest values. I also use an eraser to bring out some of the specular highlights in the skin. Since the focal point is the face itself I didn't spend a whole lot of time on the shawl. At this point I usually double check things with my reference and call it good. I have a bad habit of overworking pieces, so I have had to learn to leave well enough alone.

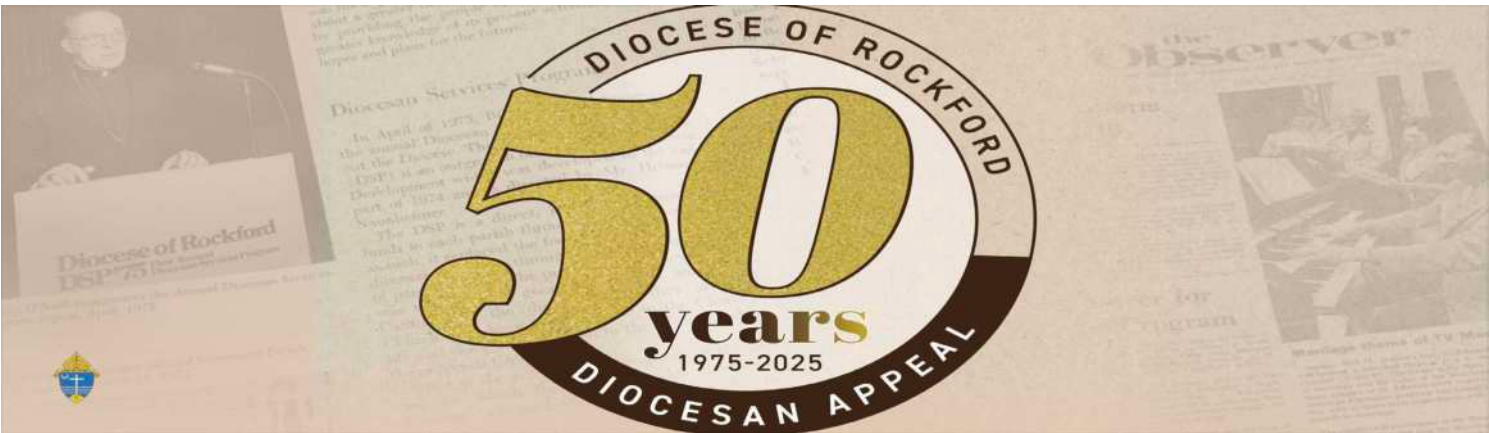

Moms Walking with in Need **QUESTIONS ANSWERED**

Why are you only accepting some baby items?

Limited storage space is driving many decisions with this new ministry. For now, we are collecting basic items that we believe will meet the needs of the most moms. As the ministry grows and we develop a relationship with our actual moms, we will be able to tweak our wish list to better meet their specific needs.

Why are you only accepting NEW car seats and pack and plays?

By distributing new equipment, we can assure that we are not passing along defective, expired or recalled items that could potentially harm the children we serve. There are many brands and styles of baby equipment on the market making it nearly impossible to keep up with manufacturer recalls. Moms can register their NEW items with the manufacturers to receive timely notifications should any issues arise with the equipment we distribute.

How often will you be collecting donations?

We will make specific requests on the Respect Life page of the bulletin whenever we need to replenish our inventory of baby items. We also hope to hold an annual baby shower each October (Respect Life Month) to restock our shelves. **Since storage space is very limited, please do not leave any donated items at church unless we request them. Thanks in advance for understanding.**
