BEAUTY IN NATURE

Nature itself can be very beautiful. If you have eyes, you have probably noticed that already. I have always had a strong appreciation and love for this great natural beauty, which is ultimately reflecting the goodness and creative order that only comes from God. However, as we have probably seen in our culture, an appreciation for nature can often turn into an obsession, where ecology almost turns into its own new-aged pseudo-religion. We recognize that nature is given to us by God, but nature is itself is not God. It's beauty is meant to lead us beyond itself to its author. The beauty in our world is always pointing upward, never down.

When I was on pilgrimage with my class in seminary, I was one of the photographers. As we traveled, I realized that often what made natural scenes interesting for me was the lighting. I found morning and afternoon to be the best times to shoot because of how dynamic the light would become and the way colors would often shift in those environments. 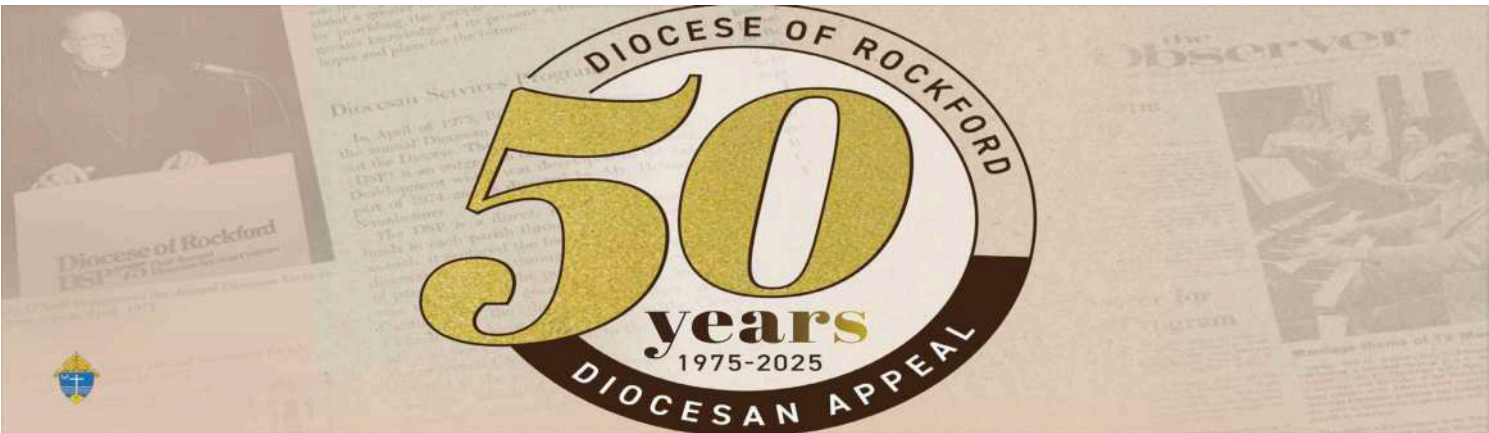
