

# FROM THE PASTOR

#### Dear Parish Family,

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome—the cathedral church of the Pope, who is Bishop of Rome. Though St. Peter's Basilica is more famous, it is St. John Lateran that holds the title "Omnium urbis et orbis ecclesiarum mater et caput" — "The mother and head of all the churches of the city and the world."

The Lateran Basilica is the oldest church building in the West, dedicated in the year 324 A.D. by Pope Sylvester I after Emperor Constantine gave the Lateran palace to the Church. Through centuries of fires, earthquakes, and restorations, it has stood as the symbol of the Church's unity and endurance. Within its walls, ecumenical councils have been held, popes have been enthroned, and countless generations of Christians have worshiped the Lord.

For us here at St. Peter Parish in Geneva, this feast reminds us that our local parish is part of something far greater: the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church spread throughout the world. The Lateran Basilica represents that universal communion which flows from Christ, our true cornerstone.

In today's readings, St. Paul reminds us, "You are God's building... the temple of the Holy Spirit" (1 Cor 3:9, 16). The Church is not only a structure of stone, but a living temple built of living stones—you and me. Every act of prayer, mercy, and faith strengthens that temple and makes God's presence shine in our world.

As we give thanks for the Lateran Basilica and our own sacred church of St. Peter, may we be renewed in our love for the Lord and for His Church.
