FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

In today's Gospel, Jesus looks upon the grandeur of the Temple—its stones, beauty, and splendor—and foretells its destruction. His words shocked His listeners. How could something so magnificent fall? Yet Jesus shifts their focus from earthly structures to the endurance of faith: "By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

The Lord reminds us that no matter what trials, confusion, or opposition we face, our faith must rest not on what is passing but on what is eternal. The true temple is Christ Himself, and in Him we find strength to endure. When life feels uncertain or overwhelming, Jesus calls us to steadfast trust—holding fast to Him in prayer, charity, and fidelity to the Gospel.

As the Church's liturgical year draws to a close, this reading invites us to reflect on how well we've persevered in faith throughout the year. Have we built our lives on Christ, or on things that fade away? The Lord promises that not a hair of our head will perish if we remain faithful to Him.

Please take time to review it prayerfully and join me in giving thanks to God for all He continues to do in and through our parish community.

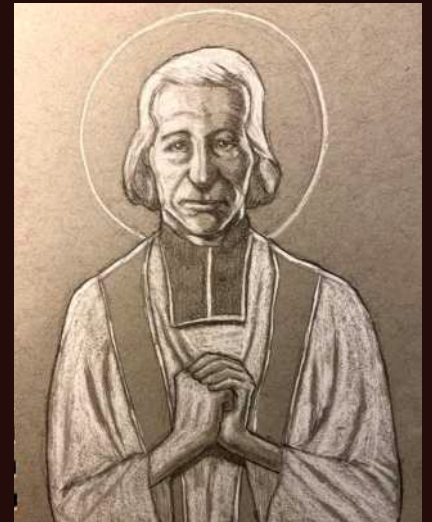

VOCATIONS AWARENESS

As some of you may know, this week was National Vocations Awareness Week. It is incredibly important for us to pray for more vocations. To the priesthood, religious and consecrated life and even to marriage as well. It is a surprise to no one to say that we have a "vocations crisis" in this country. We need more young people to answer the Lord's call for their lives. We don't have a whole lot of priests in this country. It is becoming more and more common for a single priest to be put in charge of multiple parishes. In a few dioceses that is the norm for almost all pastors. Religious and consecrated vocations, while down, have been steadily picking back up. But we still feel the effects. Religious communities are no longer regularly seen assisting in parishes. And lastly, believe it or not, marriage is down too, and not just marriages in the Church. Less and less young people are getting married. As someone who was in seminary for eight years I would often hear many a unsolicited opinion about how the priestly vocations crisis was due to the Church's "backwards" mentality of priestly celibacy. Essentially, if the Church wants more priests, she should allow them to get married. While there are many other problems with this claim, young men seem to not want to get married either. Our culture seems to favor single life or noncommittal romantic relationships.

People nowadays seem afraid to give their lives away, to follow the Lord's call and commit to the way of life to which he calls them. So, I urge all of you to pray for vocations. First to pray for more seminarians and priests. I myself am asking big from the Lord this year and praying for six new seminarians to join for the 2026-2027 academic year. I encourage you to join me in this. If you yourself are a young man who has felt the Lord working in your heart in this regard, please reach out to myself or Father Browning, we would love to walk with you and aid your discernment! Pray also for more religious vocations, that young men and women may follow the Lord's call to a life of deeper prayer and service. And lastly pray for more vocations to marriage. The family is the fundamental unit of society. Pray that young men and women may answer the Lord's call to love and serve Him through how they love and serve each other and their children.

On this vain the image for this week is an image of St. John Vianney that I drew years ago. He is the patron saint of priests, but we could also consider him the patron saint of vocations, since he walked with those of all vocations. This wasn't a style I typically drew in, it was more exaggerated than I wanted it to be, but ended up okay nonetheless.

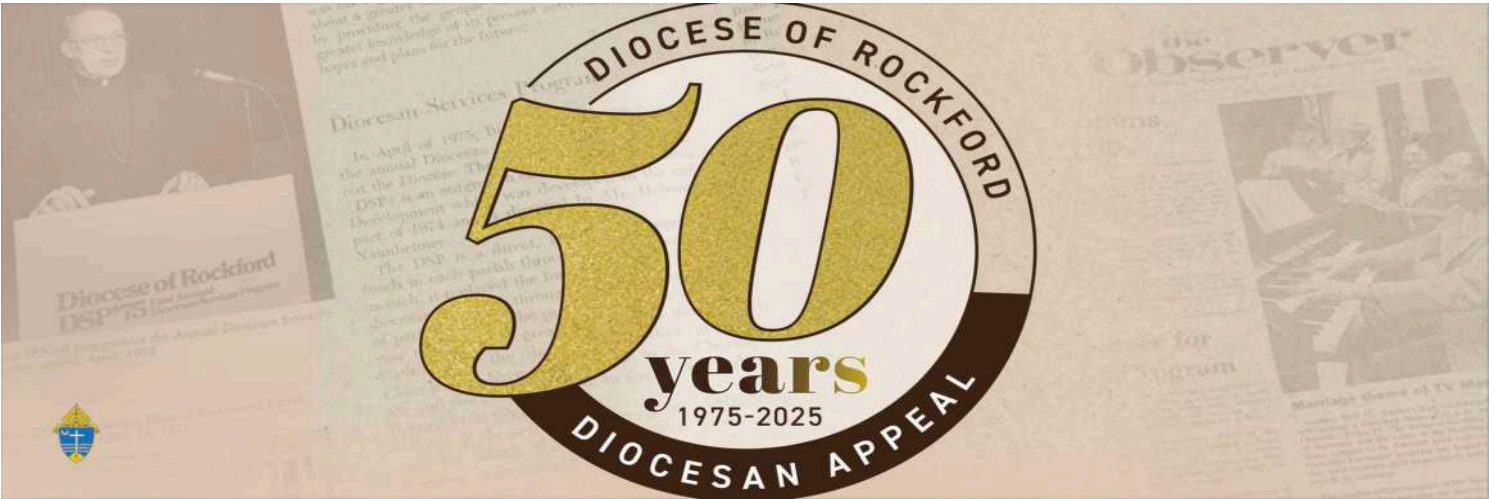

Please contact Governor Pritzker to VETO SB 1950 - Legalizing Assisted Suicide

At 2:54 a.m. on October 31 the Illinois State Senate narrowly passed SB 1950. The State House narrowly passed the bill in the Spring. The bill is now on the Governor's desk. This is the last chance to stop assisted suicide from becoming law in Illinois.

In Canada where assisted suicide has been legal since 2016, 1 in 20 deaths are now due to assisted suicide/euthanasia. Too many are giving up on life under this law.

PLEASE CALL GOV. PRITZKER AND INFORM HIM:

- **People with disabilities, the poor and marginalized fear coercion and abuse under assisted suicide laws.**
- **Suicide rates increase in states where assisted suicide is legal, especially among veterans.**
- **There is a possible cost savings to insurance companies as they can provide cheaper lethal drugs instead of lifesaving treatments.**

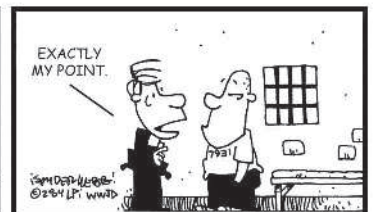
