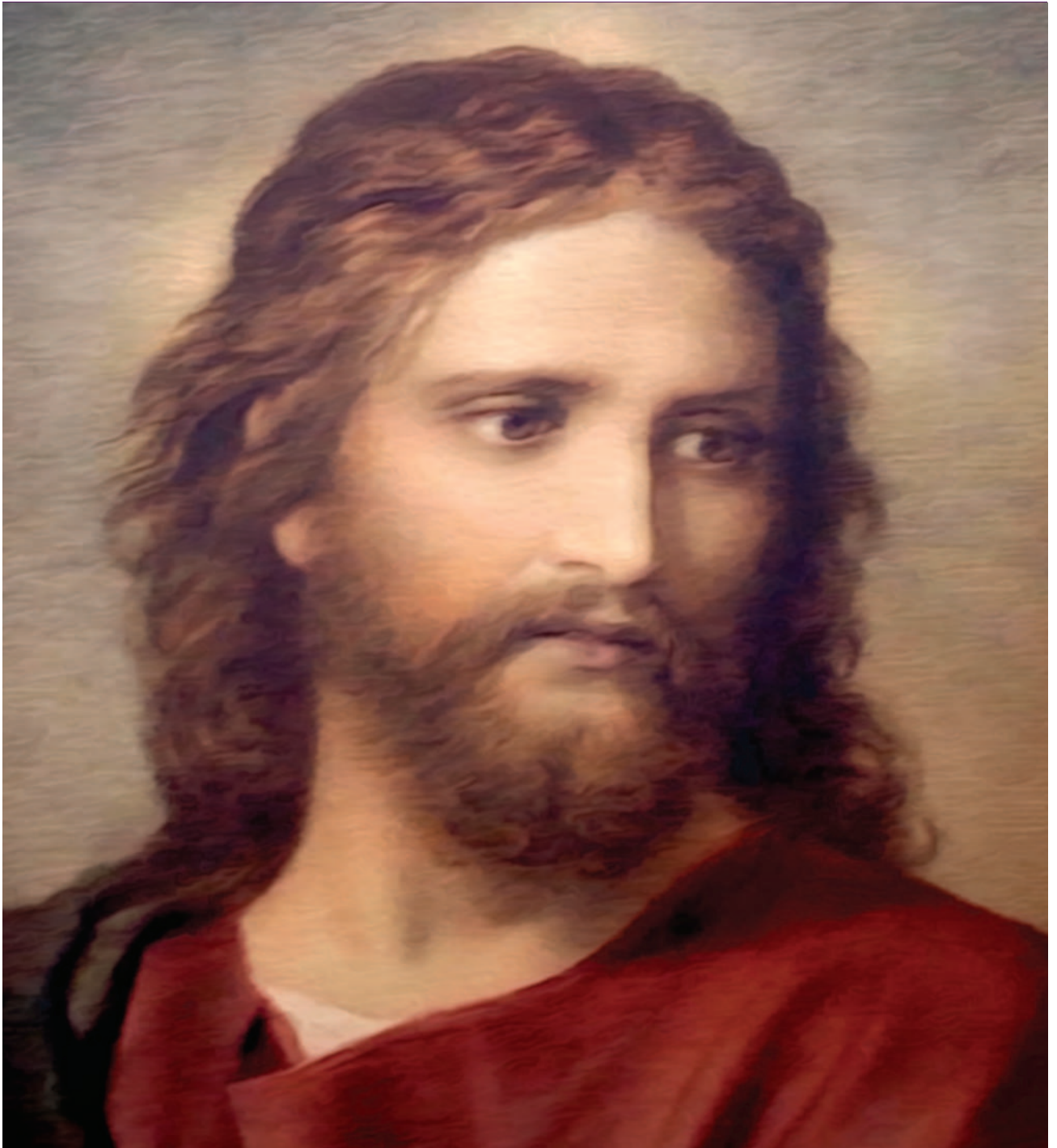

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

Advent: A Season to Deepen Our Life of Prayer

As we begin the holy season of Advent, the Church invites us once again to enter into a time of longing, quiet expectation, and renewed devotion. Each year, this season prepares our hearts to welcome Christ more deeply into our lives. This Advent at St. Peter Parish, we will focus in a particular way on the gift of prayer—how to grow in it, how to return to it, and how to allow it to transform us.

Prayer is our lifeline to God.

At its heart, prayer is simply the raising of our minds and hearts to God. It is a conversation grounded in love. The Church teaches that prayer takes many forms—blessing and adoration, petition, intercession, thanksgiving, and praise. Some prayers use beautiful traditional words; others arise from the quiet of our hearts. Some moments of prayer are filled with deep consolation, while others feel dry and difficult. Yet every moment we offer to God—whether joyful, distracted, or silent—is precious to Him.

This Advent, I invite every parishioner and family to take a step forward in prayer:

- Set aside daily time—even five minutes—for silence with the Lord.
- Pray with Scripture through the Psalms or the Sunday readings.
- Bring your needs, worries, and hopes honestly before God.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to renew your desire for prayer.

You will be amazed at how even small commitments create space for grace.

Hallow offers guided meditations, daily Gospel reflections, music, Rosaries, novenas, sleep prayers, content for kids, and excellent Advent offerings featuring voices like Bishop Barron, Jonathan Roumie, Sr. Miriam James Heidland, and more. In the coming weeks, we will provide free access for every parishioner through a St. Peter parish-wide subscription. Details on how to sign up will be announced soon. My hope is that this resource will help each of us carve out consistent, meaningful moments of prayer—whether at home, on the go, or even as a family.

As we enter this sacred season, may the Lord draw us closer to His heart. May our parish become a community rooted in prayer, strengthened by grace, and eager to welcome Christ anew. Be assured of my prayers for all of you.

THE ARK

As we say in the creed, Jesus was "conceived by the Holy Spirit" and "born of the Virgin Mary". Mary plays a pivotal role in the incarnation of our Lord. She becomes a true vessel of God's presence, a tabernacle. Similar to the one which the Israelites carried through the dessert, the Ark of the Covenant, in which the tablets of the Law, a.k.a the Ten Commandments, and the presence of God dwelt. It is interesting when the Holy Family flees from Herod, they go to Egypt. Their flight is a strange inversion of the Exodus story. The new Ark of the Covenant, the new tabernacle, Mary being brought back to the place of bondage for the people of Israel through the desert. Of course, they eventually return, a true "there and back again". But the Exodus parallel I do not think is by accident.

Mary is the New Ark and what God is signaling through this new Ark is that a new Exodus is dawning for the people of Israel. A new deliverer is coming, a new Moses. Except this one does not bring the Law, he is the Law. He does not echo the words of God, he is the Word of God, the Word made flesh. The Promised Land he points to is not a finite plot of land, but an eternal dwelling. And it is Mary who holds all this expectation in her heart and in her womb. This week's image is a portrait of Our Lady drawn some time ago in graphite. I think I used her depiction in The Chosen Christmas Special as reference.

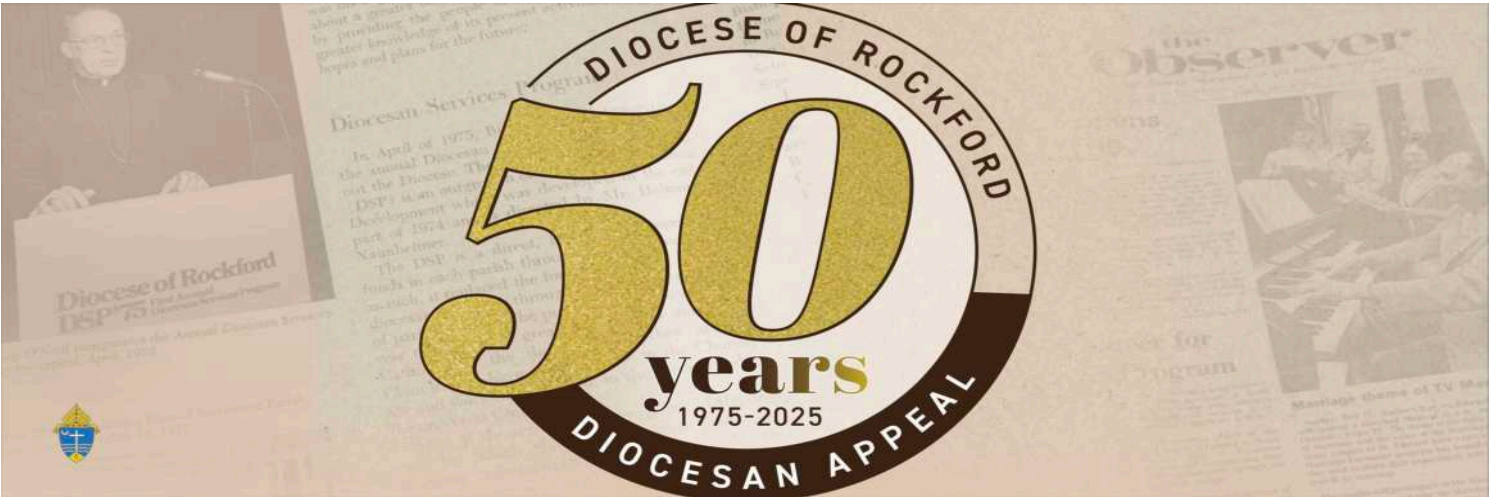
ADORATION CHAPEL

In order to streamline donation reporting, we will send contribution statements to **ALL** who have donated \$1.00 or more in 2025. **Donations for 2025 must be post marked on or before December 31, 2025 to be included as 2025 donations.**

If you have yet to financially support the parish, now is a great time to start. We cannot answer our call to do God's work through the sacraments, ministries, religious education and more without your financial assistance!

We will email statements to families with email addresses in our database and mail all others via First Class mail. All statements will be sent by January 31, 2026.

If you have requested a hard copy to be mailed in the past, you should receive one for 2025 as well. If you have not received a hard copy in the past but wish to have one going forward, contact the parish office. Please note, those who receive a hard copy in the mail will also receive the email version if we have a current email address on file.

For statements including school tuition payments and donations, please log into your FACTS account to generate a statement. You may call the School Office if you have further questions regarding this process.

OUR MINISTRIES

HAPPY ADVENT! We are thankful for the generous donation from CIACO-Baskets of Love who provided 25 turkeys with complete holiday meals. We are also grateful to HomeCourt Real Estate of Geneva for their Thanksgiving food drive! It was a huge success! We are very blessed and inspired by the parish and community donations to the food pantry! The amount of food, birthday bags and monetary gifts really make a difference in meeting the needs of our neighbors! We are distributing food to over 200 families at each distribution, so every gift is a very special blessing for our neighbors with food insecurities. Please know that we pray for each of you this Christmas season and always.

We are anticipating about 220 families for our Christmas distribution of turkeys, hams or chickens and a "sides" box of dry foods to make a complete dinner. We are able to purchase our meat and the sides at \$30.00 each from the Northern IL Food Bank.

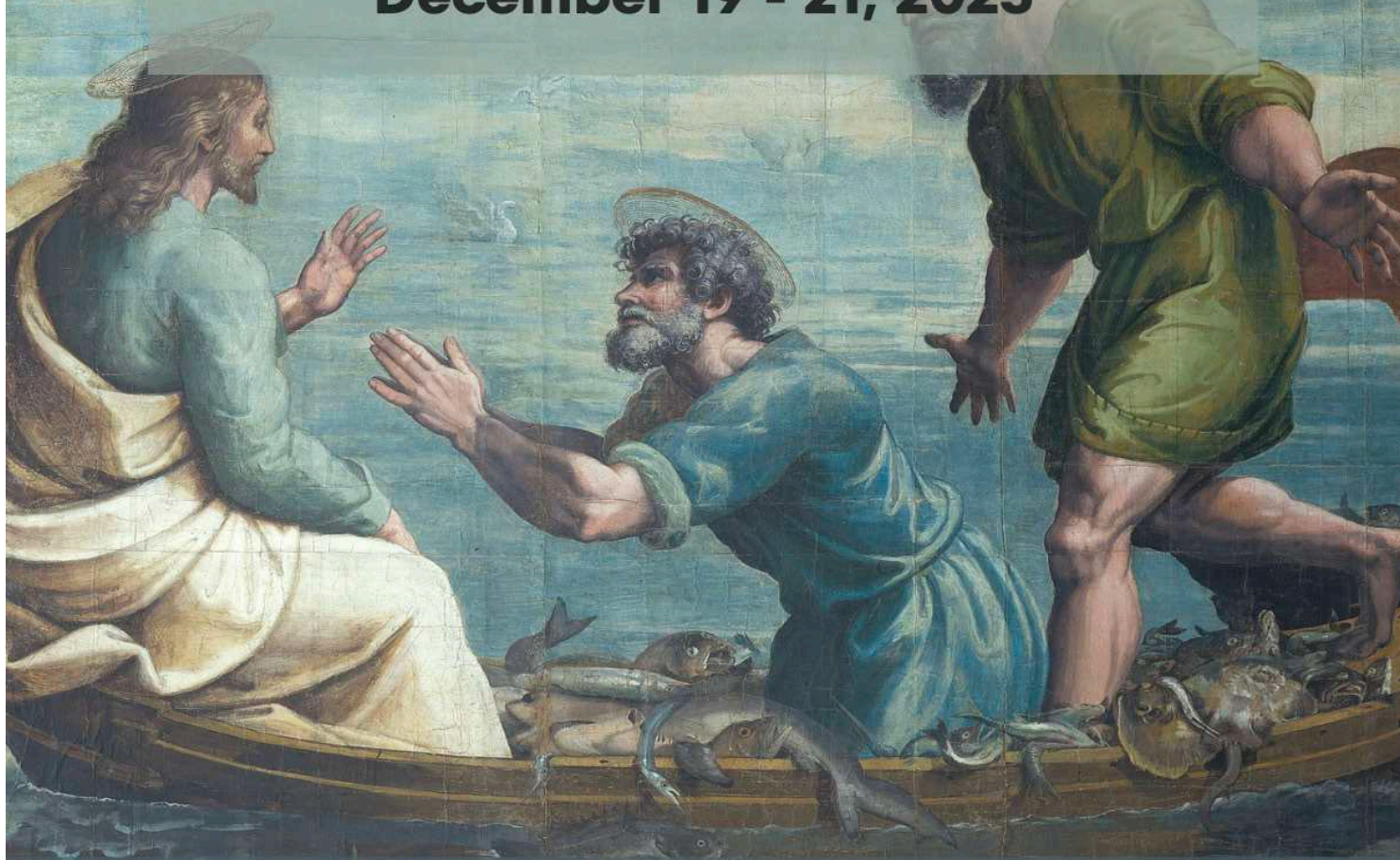
