FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which brings the Christmas season to a close and opens the door to Jesus' public ministry. At the Jordan River, Jesus steps into the waters not because He needs repentance, but to sanctify the waters themselves and to reveal who He is: the beloved Son of the Father.

As Jesus comes up from the water, the heavens are opened, the Spirit descends like a dove, and the voice of the Father proclaims, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." This moment is not only a revelation about Christ — it is also a revelation about us. Through our own baptism, we are claimed by God, washed clean of sin, and given a share in Christ's life and mission.

Baptism is not simply something that happened in the past; it is a living reality. Each day we are called to remember who we are and whose we are: beloved sons and daughters of the Father, sealed with the Holy Spirit, and sent to live as witnesses of Christ in the world. Our baptism calls us to holiness, to charity, and to faithful discipleship in our homes, workplaces, and community.

As we move now into Ordinary Time, may this feast invite us to renew our baptismal promises and to live with confidence and joy in the grace God has given us. May we listen again to the Father's voice, trust the Spirit's guidance, and follow Christ more closely each day. Be assured of my prayers for you and your families.

BAPTISM OF THE LORD

The painting I am sharing this week is quite a famous one. It is a fresco (meaning it is painted on wet plaster, so the dried paint becomes infused and fixed into the wall.) located in the Sistine Chapel. It is one of seven frescoes depicting the life of Christ. Interestingly, while there are six other frescoes, this particular painting is depicting more than one scene in the life of Christ simultaneously. On the middle left, in addition to being the one baptizing Jesus, John the Baptist is also seen preaching to his followers. And on the middle right Jesus is also seen again preaching to his followers, perhaps meant to be the Sermon on the Mount. There are a couple interesting ideas at play here. Firstly, the choice to put John on the left and Jesus at the right. A great many languages, latin and italiano included, are read left to right. So, when we read the painting in the same way we are meant to look from John to Christ. Showing how John's ministry and preaching leads to and points to the person of Christ. Secondly, juxtaposing the preaching of John and Christ with baptism shows how both Jesus and John's ministry is meant to lead to baptism in Christ. It is through baptism in Christ that we receive the graces of salvation. It is to the Church, built on the rock St. Peter, that these sacraments have been given. (Which also probably explains why it is Rome painted in the background and not Jerusalem.) The celebration of the Baptism of the Lord is a great act of rejoicing and thanksgiving for the gift of baptism that the Lord has extended to us. So, let us all try to even more deeply, root ourselves in our baptismal identity.


