

St. Peter's Youth Ministry exists to empower teens to pray boldly, embrace God's grace in the sacraments, and foster faith that lasts a lifetime. This semester, St. Peter Youth Ministry will be focusing on Sacraments and Service, inviting our middle and high school students to grow in friendship, faith, and a deeper encounter with Jesus. Through prayer, games, discussions, service projects, and adoration, we hope to create a space where teens feel welcomed, known, and encouraged to ponder the Gospel.

Middle School Youth Ministry meets on Sunday evenings twice a month, and all students in 6th-8th grade are invited. This summer, our Middle School students (current 6th-8th graders) are invited to join us for Summer Camp at Covenant Harbor in Lake Geneva, Wis. from June 9th-12th. Summer Camp features swimming and boating, high ropes, music, adoration, and much more!

High School Youth Ministry meets on Thursday evenings every week. This semester's series is called Our Table: Scripture, Snacks, and Honest Faith. We'll discuss Fr. Mike Schmitz videos, pray, and eat together. Our high school teens are also welcome to help lead Middle School YM evenings (contact Emily Delaney to become involved). Over the summer, we also offer our Steubenville Conference trip for High School students. We are planning on attending Mid-America I from July 10th-12th.





HELP US KEEP OUR DIRECTORY UPDATED!

Please remember to update your address, contact info, children, etc. Our biggest reminder is for young adults to register as their own family! There is no magic answer to when a person becomes an "adult" within the Church. However, in order to establish their role as stewards of the Church, we recommend young adults register on their own once they have a job and a somewhat permanent address (not running back and forth from college campuses). For some, this is not an age, but a stage in life when they begin their own history of actively practicing their faith.

For others, a logical age to be established independently is the age of 23.

Even if living at home with mom and dad, young adults should register with the parish. If no longer at home and living in another area, they should register with the parish where they live. Once registered on their own either at St. Peter or elsewhere, it is important to notify St. Peter so we can remove them as active members of their parents' household.

This question of adulthood often comes up when a person is asked to be a sponsor for someone receiving a sacrament or wishes to be married in the Church, but has never established themselves beyond their parent's family registration.

Once registered on their own, young adults who engage in stewardship of time, talent and treasure are able to build a record of sorts that they are actively participating in parish life. In essence, it helps them take ownership of their faith. It is important for young adults to be registered independently, as they are the future of our Church and society in general.

It is another step in their journey of adulthood.




