# FROM THE PASTOR

*Dear Parish Family,*

In today's Gospel, Jesus proclaims the Beatitudes—words we've heard so often that we can forget how radical they are. The world tells us we are blessed when we are strong, successful, comfortable, and admired. Jesus says something entirely different: Blessed are the poor in spirit, the meek, the merciful, the pure of heart, the peacemakers.

The Beatitudes are not simply moral ideals or inspirational sayings. They are a portrait of Jesus Himself. He is the poor one who trusts the Father completely, the meek one who gives His life without violence, the merciful one who forgives sinners, the peacemaker who reconciles us to God through the Cross. To live the Beatitudes, then, is not merely to follow rules—it is to conform our lives to Christ.

Saint Paul reminds us today that God often chooses what the world considers weak or insignificant to reveal His power. This is good news for us. Holiness is not reserved for the perfect or the impressive. It is lived in quiet fidelity, humility, mercy, and love—often in ways the world never notices.

As we begin this week, we might ask ourselves: Where is Christ inviting me to live one Beatitude more intentionally? In a relationship that needs mercy, in a situation that calls for humility, or in a moment where peace needs to be chosen over pride? True happiness—true blessedness—is found not in grasping for power, but in trusting God and walking in the way of Christ.





## HELP US KEEP OUR DIRECTORY UPDATED!

Please remember to update your address, contact info, children, etc. Our biggest reminder is for young adults to register as their own family! There is no magic answer to when a person becomes an "adult" within the Church. However, in order to establish their role as stewards of the Church, we recommend young adults register on their own once they have a job and a somewhat permanent address (not running back and forth from college campuses). For some, this is not an age, but a stage in life when they begin their own history of actively practicing their faith. For others, a logical age to be established independently is the age of 23.

Even if living at home with mom and dad, young adults should register with the parish. If no longer at home and living in another area, they should register with the parish where they live. Once registered on their own either at St. Peter or elsewhere, it is important to notify St. Peter so we can remove them as active members of their parents' household.

This question of adulthood often comes up when a person is asked to be a sponsor for someone receiving a sacrament or wishes to be married in the Church, but has never established themselves beyond their parent's family registration.

Once registered on their own, young adults who engage in stewardship of time, talent and treasure are able to build a record of sorts that they are actively participating in parish life. In essence, it helps them take ownership of their faith. It is important for young adults to be registered independently, as they are the future of our Church and society in general.

It is another step in their journey of adulthood.


