FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

During National Marriage Week, the Church invites us to reflect with gratitude on the gift of marriage and to renew our commitment to supporting married couples through prayer, grace, and sacramental life. Marriage is not simply a human institution or social contract; it is a sacrament, established by Christ, through which husband and wife are strengthened and sanctified for a lifelong vocation of love. The Catechism teaches that in the Sacrament of Matrimony, “Christ dwells with them, gives them the strength to take up their crosses and so follow him, to rise again after they have fallen, to forgive one another, to bear one another’s burdens, and to be subject to one another out of reverence for Christ” (CCC 1642). In other words, marriage flourishes not by human effort alone, but by God’s grace at work within it.

Prayer is essential to this growth. When spouses pray together—whether through simple daily prayer, Scripture, the Rosary, or spontaneous conversation with God—they invite the Lord into the heart of their relationship. Prayer softens hearts, deepens unity, and renews love, especially during times of difficulty. As the Catechism reminds us, married couples are called to help one another grow in holiness (cf. CCC 1641).

The sacraments are the primary source of this strength. Frequent reception of the Eucharist nourishes married love by uniting couples more deeply to Christ’s self-giving love, while the Sacrament of Reconciliation brings healing, mercy, and renewal—both individually and within the marriage itself. When couples remain close to the sacraments, they allow God’s grace to shape their love into a faithful, forgiving, and life-giving witness.

During National Marriage Week, all parishioners are encouraged to pray for married couples, engaged couples, and families within our community. Married couples might take this opportunity to recommit themselves to shared prayer, Mass attendance, and sacramental life. As the Catechism teaches, marriage is ordered toward the good of the spouses and the building up of the Church itself (cf. CCC 1601).

May this week be a time of renewed grace, inviting all of us to support and strengthen the vocation of marriage—one rooted in prayer, sustained by the sacraments, and lived in the love of Christ.
