

# FROM THE PASTOR

*Dear Parish Family,*

As we enter the First Sunday of Lent, the Gospel places us beside Jesus in the desert (Matthew 4:1–11). Before His public ministry begins, the Lord withdraws into silence, fasting and praying, and there He confronts temptation. Lent invites each of us to make that same spiritual journey — not to escape the world, but to rediscover who we are in God.

The desert is not only a physical place; it represents the quiet space where our hearts are purified. In a world filled with noise, distraction, and constant activity, Lent calls us back to what matters most: prayer, conversion, and trust in the Father. Jesus shows us that temptation is overcome not by our own strength, but by clinging to the Word of God.

At St. Peter Parish, I encourage every family and every parishioner to choose one concrete step this week:

- Deepen prayer — even a few extra minutes of silence with the Lord each day.
- Embrace sacrifice — letting go of something that creates more room for Christ.
- Practice charity — reaching out to someone who needs encouragement or support.

Lent is not meant to be gloomy; it is a season of hope. The Church leads us through forty days of renewal so that our hearts may be ready to rejoice fully at Easter. If you have been away from Mass or the Sacrament of Reconciliation, know that this is a beautiful time to return. The Lord never tires of welcoming us back.

Let us walk together through this sacred season, asking the Holy Spirit to renew our parish, our families, and our own hearts. May Our Lord lead us through the desert and bring us to the joy of the Resurrection.

Let's make room for Him. One hour. One less distraction. One more step toward heaven.
