

# FROM THE PASTOR

*Dear Parish Family,*

This Sunday, the Church presents one of the most powerful and personal encounters in the Gospel: Jesus' meeting with the Samaritan woman at the well (John 4:5-42). Jesus, weary from His journey, sits beside Jacob's well at noon and asks a Samaritan woman for a drink. What begins as a simple request becomes a profound moment of grace. The woman arrives carrying the burdens of her life and her past, yet Jesus meets her exactly where she is. In doing so, He breaks through cultural, religious, and personal barriers to reach her heart.

Jesus tells her that anyone who drinks ordinary water will become thirsty again, but the water He gives will become within a person "a spring of water welling up to eternal life." The "living water" Jesus offers is the life of grace and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Like the Samaritan woman, we often approach life seeking to satisfy our thirst with things that ultimately leave us empty. Christ, however, offers something far greater—true fulfillment that only He can give. Lent is a season when the Church invites us to recognize our spiritual thirst and allow Christ to satisfy it.

During their conversation, Jesus gently reveals that He knows the truth about her life. Rather than condemning her, He leads her toward conversion and freedom. He then speaks of true worship, telling her that the Father seeks those who will worship Him "in Spirit and truth." This worship reaches its fullness in the Holy Mass, where we encounter Christ Himself and receive the grace that renews our hearts.

The transformation of the Samaritan woman is remarkable. After meeting Jesus, she leaves her water jar behind and runs back to her town to proclaim what she has experienced: "Come see a man who told me everything I have done. Could he possibly be the Christ?" The woman who once came to the well alone and burdened becomes a witness who leads others to Jesus. Her encounter with Christ changes not only her life but the lives of many others.

The Gospel reminds us that Christ knows us completely and still seeks us out. He meets us in our weakness, our thirst, and even our sins—not to condemn us but to heal and transform us. As we continue our Lenten journey, we are invited to come honestly before the Lord and ask for the living water only He can give. When we allow Christ to fill our hearts, we too can become witnesses who lead others to encounter Him.

Hope all of you are having a meaningful Lent. This year I am resurrecting a Lenten devotion my parents and I did a couple times in the past for Lent. We would pray with a Lenten prayer guide each day and then we would say a prayer for family members or friends. We would choose a different person or in some cases a couple or a family, to pray for each day in Lent. Then we mailed them a note card stating that we prayed for them on such and such a day and we also included an "I Said A Prayer For You Today" prayer card.

This year my parents and I chose to listen to the Hallow Lent Pray40: The Return, as our Lenten guide. Each night we listen to the session of the day. Then we pray for a particular person/couple/family each day. Then I send them a text letting them know we said a prayer for them today and ask them if there is anything specific they would like us to pray for. I also text them a picture of the "I Said A Prayer For You Today" prayer card.

I find this route instantaneous and is quicker than snail mail. It gives them a chance to let us know if they have a special need to pray for and gives opportunity for dialogue that may not have happened otherwise. When we pray for others, God listens. Always know that someone is praying for you.


