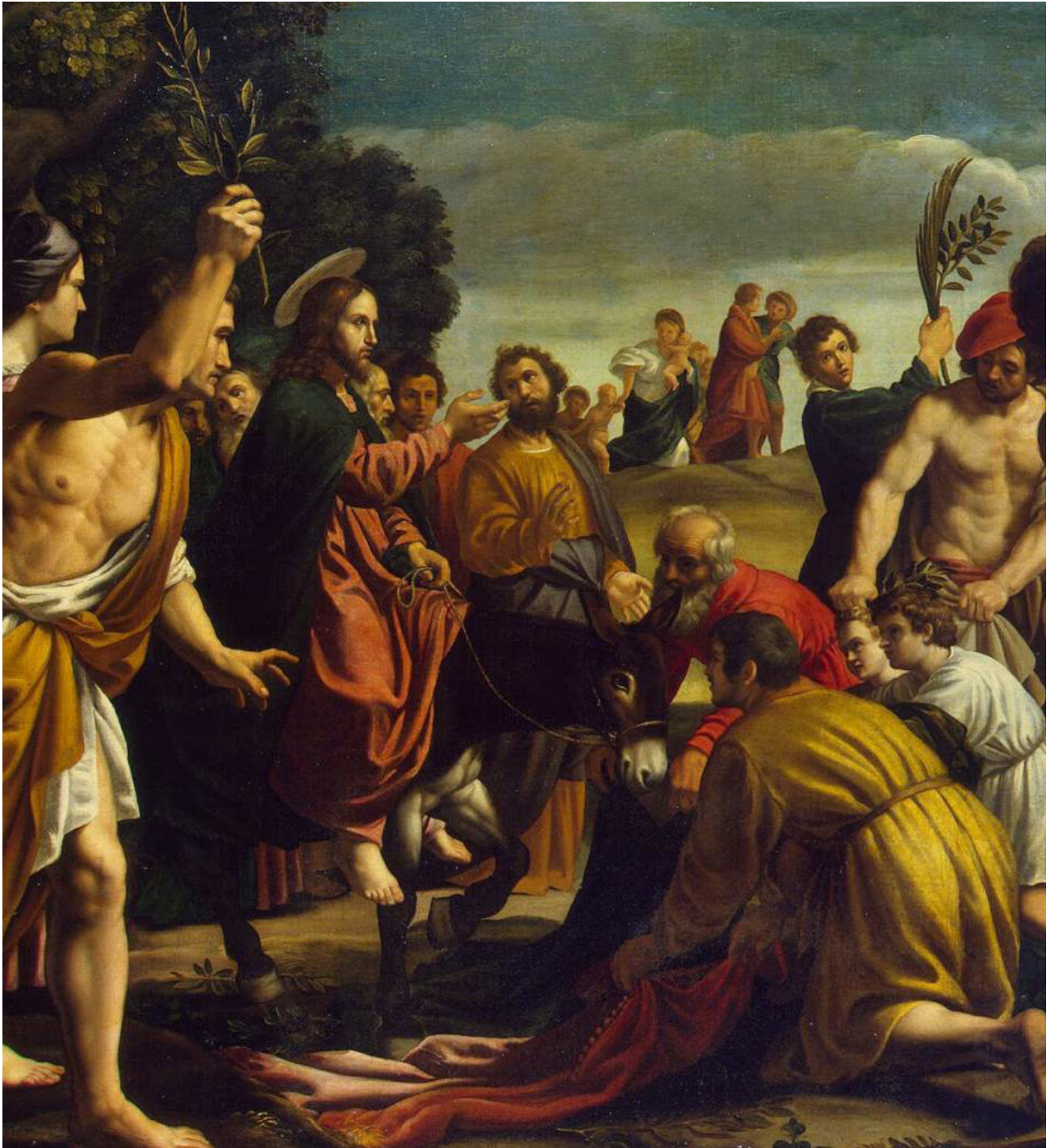

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

As we enter Holy Week, the Church invites us into the most sacred days of the entire year. These are not simply days to remember something that happened long ago—they are days to enter into the saving mysteries of Jesus Christ. We are not spectators. We are participants.

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday, where we hold in tension both the triumph of Christ's entrance into Jerusalem and the sorrow of His Passion. The same voices that cry out "Hosanna!" will soon cry out "Crucify Him!" It is a powerful reminder of how easily the human heart can turn—and how deeply we need redemption.

The heart of the week is the Sacred Triduum:

- Holy Thursday draws us into the Upper Room, where Jesus gives us the gift of the Eucharist and the priesthood. In humble service, He washes the feet of His disciples and commands us to love as He has loved.
- Good Friday brings us to the foot of the Cross. Here we stand with Mary and John, contemplating the depth of Christ's sacrifice. This is the day we see most clearly what our salvation costs: the total gift of Jesus' life for us.
- Holy Saturday is a day of silence and waiting. The Church keeps watch at the tomb, holding onto hope in the darkness, preparing for the joy of the Resurrection.

Then comes the great proclamation at the Easter Vigil: Christ is risen! Light breaks into darkness, and death is conquered forever. This week is not meant to be rushed. It is meant to be lived. I encourage you to make Holy Week a priority:

- Attend the liturgies of the Triduum
- Spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament
- Go to Confession
- Foster silence, especially on Good Friday and Holy Saturday

If we walk with Christ through His Passion, we will more fully share in the joy of His Resurrection. Let us not stand at a distance this week. Let us draw near to the Cross, so that we may also share in the empty tomb.

Be assured of my prayers for you and your family during these holy days.

It's always fun when you get to come to Mass and also take something home. We receive palms at this Mass as we celebrate Christ's entry into Jerusalem, where the people laid palms at his feet. Though, this day is always bittersweet. It's a triumphant entry into the city but we know what's coming next. Next weekend, we will recall Christ's last supper, betrayal, suffering, death and resurrection. The people welcome him into the city like a king, but have no idea what he is about to do. How his kingship and victory over evil will be revealed in the most paradoxical way possible.

This fresco by Pietro Lorenzetti is actually located in one of my favorite cities in the world, Assisi in Italy. It's on the wall in the lower church at the Basilica of St. Francis. I love the frenetic energy of the crowd around Jesus. They are so excited to see him arrive. You can see palms being gathered, laid out, a carpet is even laid for Jesus, yet the crowd has no idea Jesus is coming to die. They have no idea that the path they are laying out is the path to the cross. So let us also continue through the remainder of Lent and also make our way to the cross.

Dear Parishioners of St. Peter,

One of the most effective ways to participate in the You Will Be My Witnesses Campaign is through a pledge made over time. A pledge allows you to make a meaningful, even sacrificial gift, while still being attentive to your family's financial responsibilities. By spreading your gift over three years, what might seem difficult at first often becomes very manageable.

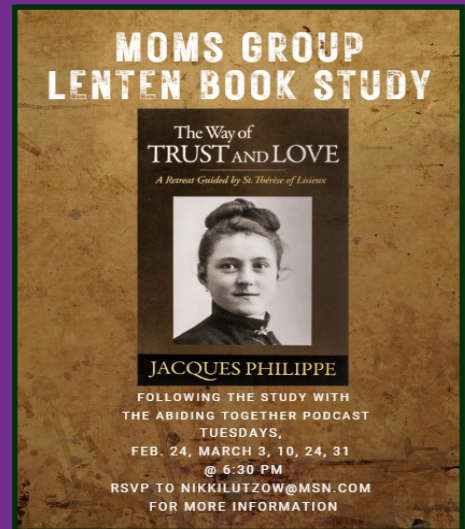

Every year the Knights of Columbus host the “Tootsie Roll Drive” for individuals with intellectual disabilities. Last year, with the help of Holy Cross and St. Peter Parishioners, we raised over \$30,000. These funds go directly back to our local community to support organizations that help those with intellectual disabilities. This week we want to highlight one of the organizations we support:

Valley Sheltered Workshop (VSW) in Batavia.

- Cozy 14(c) workshop environment provides a safe, welcoming, and self-paced workplace for those with disabilities.
- VSW coordinates with local businesses to create meaningful work tasks such as packaging, labeling, and medical supply prep.
- Most importantly, the shelter provides local citizens a place to feel welcome and avoid self-isolation through outings/group activities.
- While the employees of the shelter do get paid for their work, VSW relies completely on donations to keep the lights on.

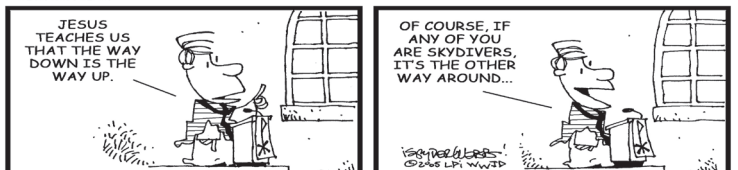
