# FROM THE PASTOR

*Dear St. Peter Family,*

This Sunday, the Church celebrates one of the most beautiful and powerful feasts of the entire year: Divine Mercy Sunday. Instituted by St. John Paul II and rooted in the revelations given to St. Faustina, this day is a profound invitation to encounter the limitless mercy of God. Jesus Himself described it as a day when “the very depths of My tender mercy are open,” and He pours out “an ocean of graces” upon those who come to Him with trust.

What is offered to us is extraordinary: the grace of complete forgiveness of sins and all punishment—a gift so radical it has often been compared to a second baptism. In a world burdened by guilt, anxiety, and restlessness, this is nothing less than a new beginning. And this invitation is for everyone. Whether you have been close to the Church or away for many years, whether your faith is strong or struggling—this day is for you.

To receive this grace, the Church asks that we:

- Go to Confession (up to 20 days before)
- Receive Holy Communion worthily (no mortal sins)
- Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)
- Be detached from all sin
- Turn to Jesus with trust, praying: “Jesus, I trust in You.”
- 

Even if you are not yet ready for all of this, begin with trust. Make a sincere act of contrition. Take a step toward God. He is already running toward you. This Easter season, do not hold back. Come home. Come to mercy. Come to Jesus.

## BEAUTY'S ARROW *Pulchritudo vulnera*

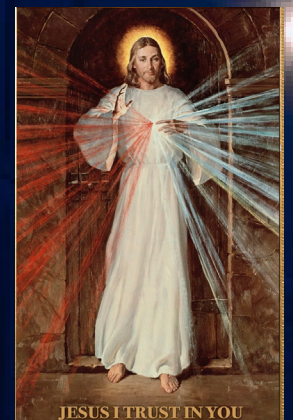
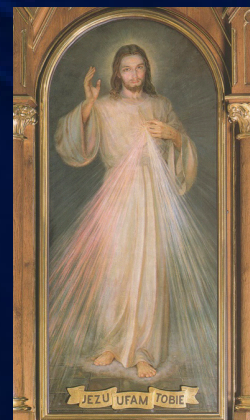
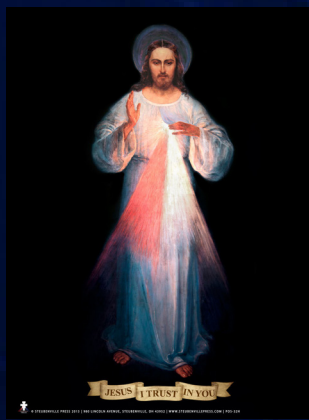
Happy Divine Mercy Sunday! This is a special feast for me because it is one of the few feasts that has a specific image associated with it, the image of Divine Mercy which was commissioned by St. Faustina after Jesus spoke to her in a vision. However, what you might not be aware of is that there are actually multiple different versions of Divine Mercy, and the most popularly reproduced one isn't actually the original.

**The Original Version (Kazimirowski):** This is the original image that Faustina oversaw, painted by artist Eugene Kazimirowski. After the whole ordeal and Faustina's multiple requests for revisions, this was the final image produced. Apparently both Kazimirowski and Faustina were both dissatisfied with it, Faustina wept when she saw it because it did not match the radiance of Christ that she experienced. Though, perhaps no earthly painting ever could. Despite this, this is perhaps my personal favorite. I love how focused it is, and how the light of Divine Mercy actually seems to be casting light on Jesus, and how it seems to be the only light source.

**The Second Version (Hyla):** This second version was painted by Adolf Hyla in thanksgiving for his family surviving WWII. It has a few distinct features, Jesus faces the viewer directly and his hand is raised higher. While these are deviations from Faustina's original specifications this is the most widely reproduced image of Divine Mercy. It is especially popular in the Philippines and Europe.

**The Third Version (Skemp):** This is a version I don't see too often, but it occasionally comes up. It was painted by Robert Skemp in the 70's at the request of the Marian Fathers. The two distinct features of this one is that the rays of Divine Mercy are radiating out to the viewer and it has an actual rendered background, depicting Jesus in front of a door. But the pose and gesture of Jesus is very similar to the Hyla version.

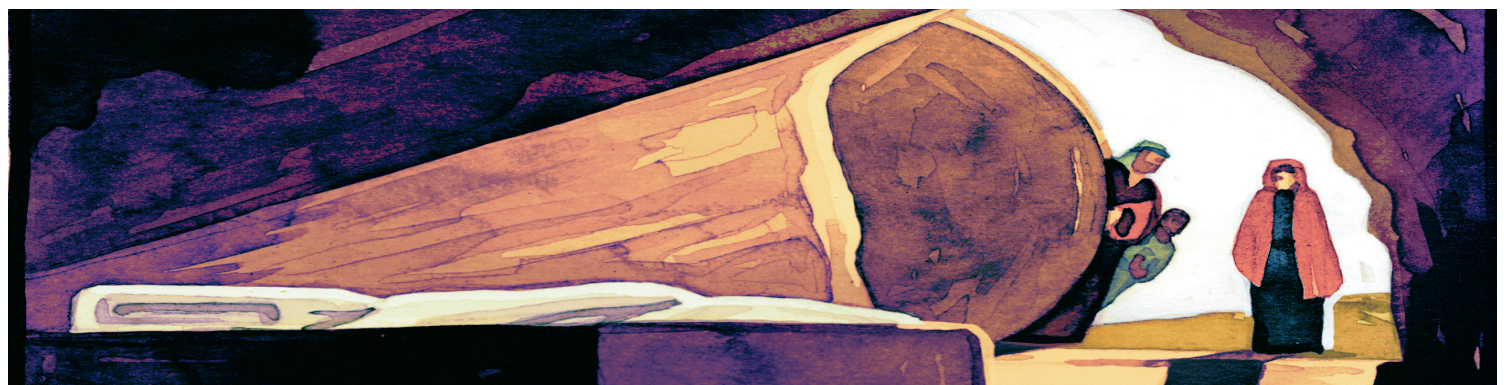

### Frequently Asked Questions: You Will Be My Witnesses Campaign

*How is our parish goal determined, and how much will St. Peter receive?*

Each parish's goal is based on its average offertory over the past three fiscal years. This helps ensure that the goal is both fair and reflective of the parish's capacity.

For every gift made by our parishioners, 40% will come directly back to St. Peter Parish to support our local projects. Even more encouraging, once we reach our goal, 60% of any additional funds raised will remain here at St. Peter, allowing us to do even more for our parish community.

*What happens if we do not reach our goal?*

There is no penalty to the parish if we do not reach the full goal. The expectation is simply that we make a sincere and faithful effort, following the guidance provided by the diocese and the Steier Group. This campaign is not about pressure—it is about participation, prayer, and generosity according to each family's ability.

Through the “You Will Be My Witnesses” Capital Campaign, funds will support:

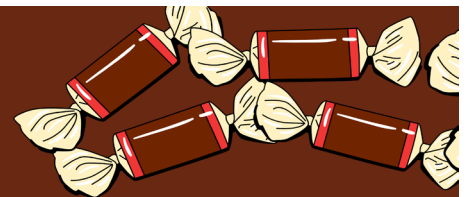

## TOOTSIE ROLL DRIVE BENEFICIARY MONTHLY HIGHLIGHT



Every year the Knights of Columbus host the "Tootsie Roll Drive" for individuals with intellectual disabilities. Last year, with the help of Holy Cross and St. Peter Parishioners, we raised over \$30,000. These funds go directly back to our local community to support organizations that help those with intellectual disabilities. This week we want to highlight one of the organizations we support:

### Marklund Hyde Center - Geneva

- Marklund is a nonprofit, 501(c)3 organization with four locations serving children and adults with profound developmental disabilities and special healthcare needs. (Geneva, Bloomingdale, Elgin locations offer community day services, residential services, and Marklund Day School. Nathan Education Center, in Elgin, is newest Marklund Day School.
- Mission: Making everyday life possible for individuals with profound disabilities.
- Provides residential facilities for 178 individuals at three main locations.
- More than 500 staff members (all locations) and hundreds of volunteers.
- Marklund Day School is licensed by the State Board of Education. The school partners with area school districts to serve children diagnosed on the autism spectrum.
- Provides Community Integration Programs that bring Marklund residents and day clients to the community - and the community to Marklund - through outings, activities, volunteer work, building vocation skills, etc.

## DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

You may not know this, but I am deeply devoted to the mercy of God—because I have experienced it so personally in my own life. And I want every one of you to experience it too. That is why I encourage you to prepare your heart for one of the most extraordinary days in the Church's year: Divine Mercy Sunday.

No matter where you are in your faith—strong, struggling, or even distant—this Sunday is for you. The Easter season is a privileged time to return to the Lord, to reconnect with His Church, and to open your heart to His merciful love. Jesus alone answers the deepest longings and restlessness of our hearts.

Jesus said to St. Faustina (Diary, 699):

"I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners... On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet."

What Jesus promises on this day is truly astonishing. He offers complete forgiveness of sins and all punishment—a grace so profound it has often been compared to a second baptism, a completely new beginning with nothing held back. This grace is offered personally to each soul who turns to Him with trust.

### How to Prepare

1. Make a sincere examination of conscience, go to confession (up to 20 days before Divine Mercy Sunday), and remain in a state of grace (no mortal sins).
2. Receive Holy Communion.
3. Trust in Jesus' mercy, repeating often: "Jesus, I trust in You."

### Plenary Indulgence

On Divine Mercy Sunday, the Church also offers a plenary indulgence (for yourself or a deceased loved one), under the usual conditions:

- Sacramental Confession (as above)
- Holy Communion (in the state of grace)
- Prayer for the Holy Father (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)
- Detachment from all sin, even venial
- Participation in Divine Mercy devotions, or prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, including the Our Father, the Creed, and "Merciful Jesus, I trust in You."

On Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12, we will have confessions at 2:00 pm and a 3:00 pm prayer service. Join us if you can. This Divine Mercy Sunday, do not stay away.

Do not be afraid. Do not think it is too late. Run to Him.

His mercy is greater than your sin.

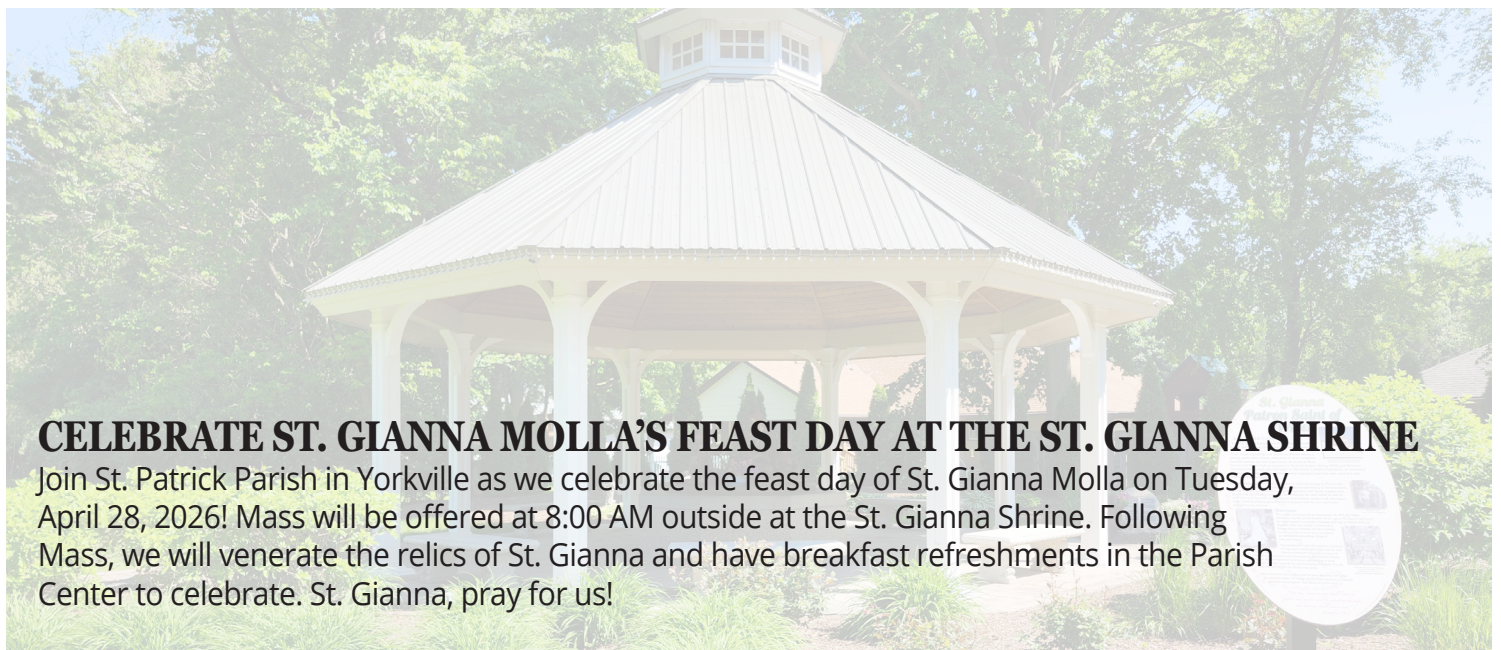

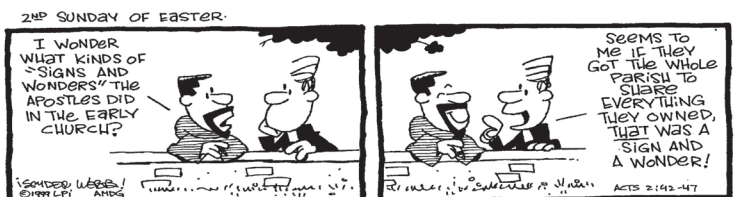
