# FROM THE PASTOR

*Dear St. Peter Family,*

*"Were not our hearts burning within us...?" (Luke 24:32)*

There is something deeply human in the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus. They are walking away from Jerusalem (biblically and metaphorically, Jerusalem is where God is present), away from hope, away from everything they thought would change their lives. Their conversation is filled with disappointment: *"We had hoped..."* How often do those words echo in our own hearts? And yet, it is precisely there on the road of confusion, grief, and unmet expectations that Jesus draws near.

They do not recognize Him at first. Their eyes are "prevented," the Gospel tells us. And isn't that true for us as well? The Lord is often closer than we realize, walking with us in our questions, our struggles, even our doubts. He listens. He accompanies. And then, gently, He begins to open the Scriptures, revealing that even suffering has meaning in God's plan.

But the turning point comes at the table.

"Stay with us," they say. And in the breaking of the bread, their eyes are opened. They recognize Him not just in words, but in the Eucharist. Then He disappeared from their sight to signify that in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist is where He wants to be seen by us. He is present Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Eucharist.

This is the pattern of the Christian life:  
Word --> Sacrament --> Mission.

We hear Him in the Scriptures.  
We encounter Him in the Eucharist.  
And then we are sent.

Notice what happens next: they rose that very hour and returned to Jerusalem. The same road that was once marked by discouragement becomes a path of urgency and joy. An encounter with the Risen Christ changes everything.

Perhaps today the Lord is asking the same of us:

To invite Him in, *"Stay with us."*

To recognize Him in the Eucharist. Make an act of faith And to allow our hearts to burn again with faith. Because once we truly encounter Him, we cannot remain where we are. We must go—back into our homes, our parish, our world—bearing witness that Jesus is alive.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today, I am announcing a special campaign to identify young men in our diocese who, through God's providence, could have a vocation to the priesthood. The campaign, entitled *Called by Name*, will take place on April 25-26, 2026.

As you know, the Diocese of Rockford has a continuing need for "more workers for the harvest." I firmly believe that many of our future priests will come from our own parishes and schools, but we need the entire Church to identify them, so that we can accompany them as they discern their vocation.



**Thursday, April 9th - 6:30pm**

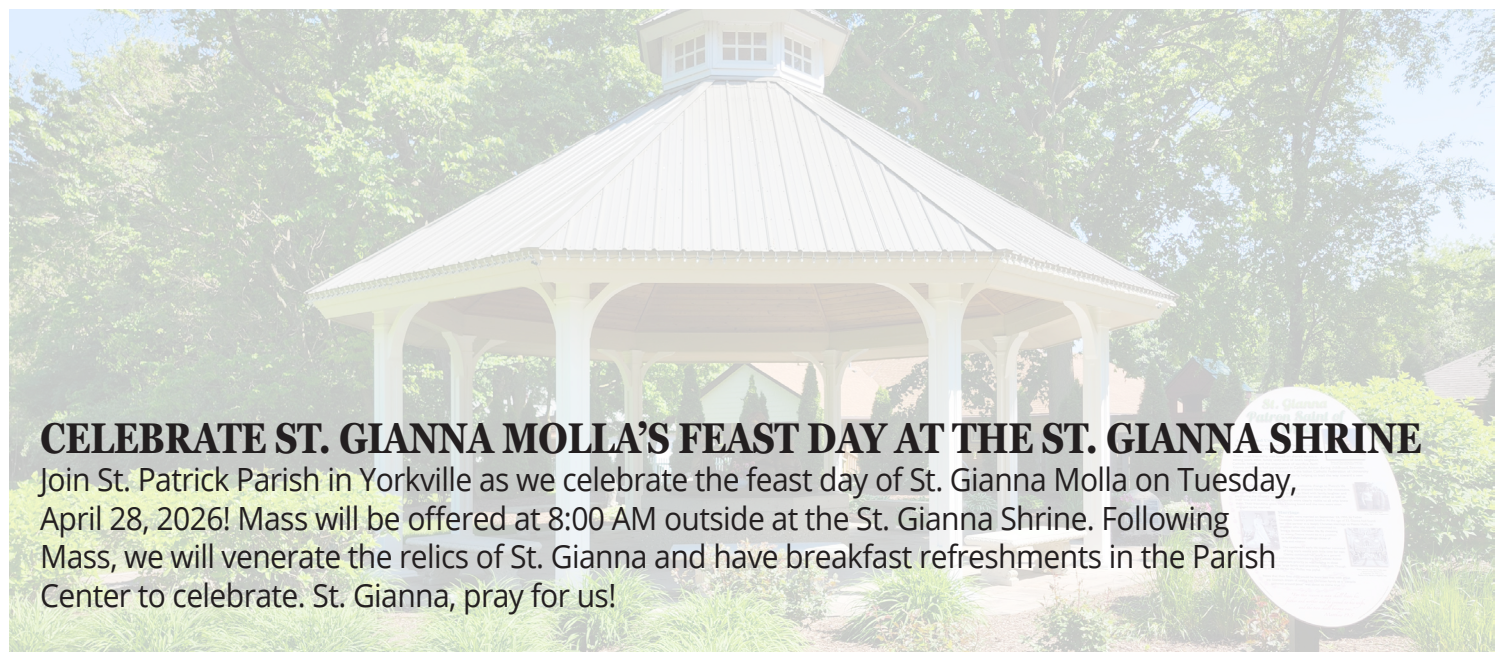

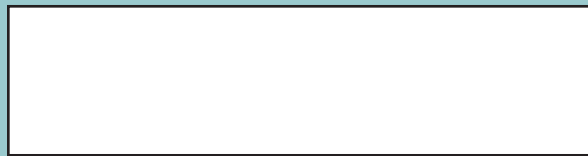
