FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Peter Family,

Each year, our parish joins with the 400,000+ Catholics across the Diocese of Rockford to support the Diocesan Appeal. Through this shared effort, we help fund essential ministries that serve both our parish and the wider Church, including marriage preparation, faith formation, Catholic Charities, seminarian and deacon formation, and many administrative services that support parish life. This appeal helps fund the yearly diocesan ministries and administration.

This year's theme, *"I Will Come to You,"* reminds us that the Church's mission is one of unity and service. What we do together as a diocesan family allows us to reach far beyond what any one parish could accomplish alone.

Our parish goal this year is \$192,197. Any amount raised beyond this goal is returned directly to our parish to support our local needs and mission.

I am very grateful for your response last year. Last year, our goal was \$190,112. Through your generosity, we raised \$216,691, through 17% participation and we have been refunded \$25,779. This refund will go toward building and grounds projects this summer.

I invite you to prayerfully consider your support of the 2026 Diocesan Appeal. I especially encourage those who have not given before to consider participating. Thank you for your generosity and for helping us live the mission of the Church.

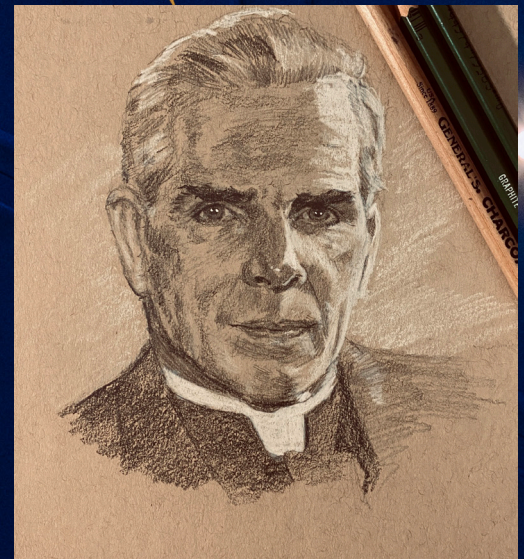
BEAUTY'S ARROW *Pulchritudo vulnera*

After library keeping classes at College of DuPage, working at a public library and two school libraries, I am blessed to be the volunteer librarian for St. Peter's Church library. My goal is for everyone to find a book that is exactly suited to your needs and interests. This is a great way to learn and grow in our faith journey.

The library is located in the narthex behind the sliding doors across from the restrooms. Since it is 'self-help', it is available whenever the Church is open. The instructions for checking out material are posted on the desk inside. As an added bonus, you can take a free bookmark (located on the bulletin board) with every book you check out. There are thirty-one (31) categories of books and two racks with DVD's. There is also a small section for children and Christian fiction books.

Also located near the coat rack in the narthex is a bookcase with books for sale for \$1.00 each. These books are either withdrawn from the library or they were donations that cannot be used, and also free sacramentals and rosary cases. Please open the doors and browse around to experience over 1,000 books! I am always happy to make recommendations and discuss books. HAPPY READING and remember what Saint Josemaria Escriva said: "Reading has made many saints".

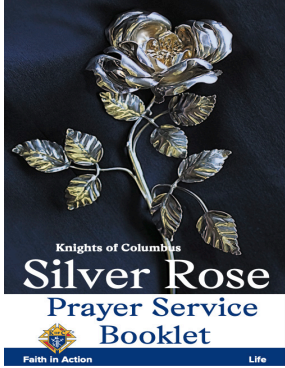

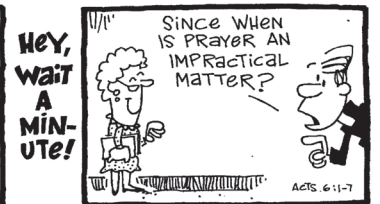
