FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Peter Family,

As we continue our journey through the Easter season, the Church gives us a profound reminder from our Lord: love is not merely a feeling—it is expressed in obedience. Obedience comes from the Latin ob-dire, which means to hear. Obedience is to hear the call of the Good Shepherd and to follow it.

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." This is not meant to be a burden, but a revelation. True love always desires to respond, to give itself, to follow. Love that remains only in words or sentiment is incomplete. Love that becomes action is transformative.

Jesus also promises something extraordinary: He will not leave us orphans. He will send the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who remains with us and within us. This promise is not just for the apostles—it is for each one of us. Through our Baptism and Confirmation, we have received the very life of God dwelling in our souls.

This means we are never alone in living the Christian life. The Holy Spirit strengthens us to:

- Choose what is right, even when it is difficult
- Remain faithful in trials
- Love others with patience and charity
- Grow in prayer and trust in God

The Christian life is not about trying harder on our own, but it is about allowing the Holy Spirit to work within us.

As we prepare for Pentecost in the coming weeks, this is a good time to ask ourselves:

- Am I attentive to the voice of the Holy Spirit in my life?
- Do I allow God's commandments to shape my decisions?
- Is my love for Christ visible in how I live each day?

Let us ask the Lord this week for a deeper love—a love that is not just spoken but lived.

Come, Holy Spirit.

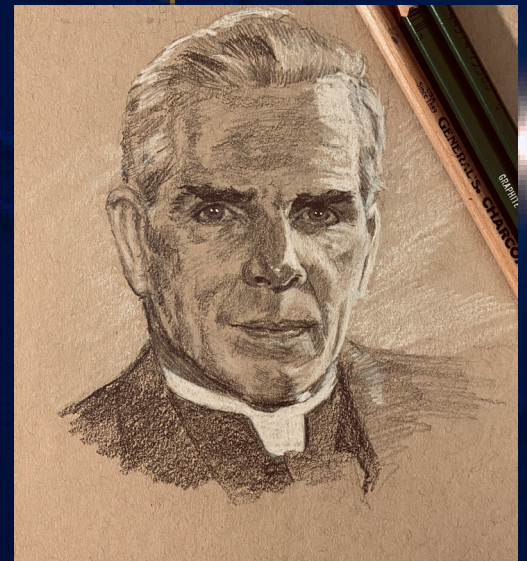
Pulchritudo vulnera

There are thirty-one (31) categories of books and two racks with DVD's. There is also a small section for children and Christian fiction books.

Also located near the coat rack in the narthex is a bookcase with books for sale for \$1.00 each. These books are either withdrawn from the library or they were donations that cannot be used, and also free sacramentals and rosary cases. Please open the doors and browse around to experience over 1,000 books! I am always happy to make recommendations and discuss books. 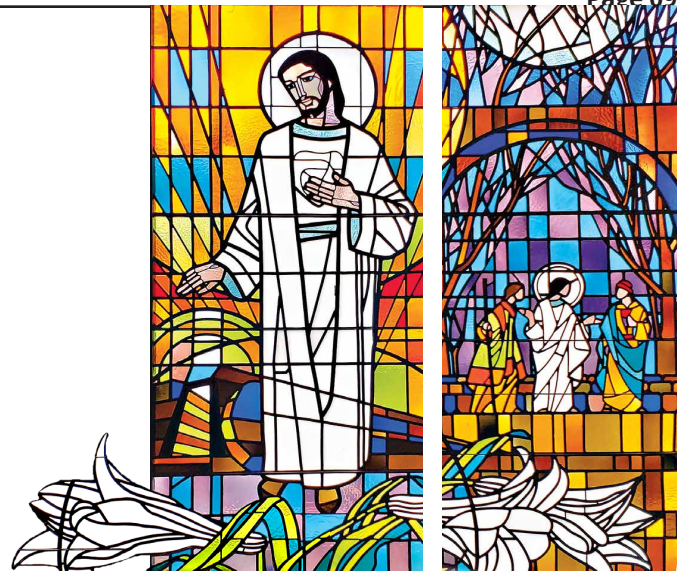

- Delivering Produce



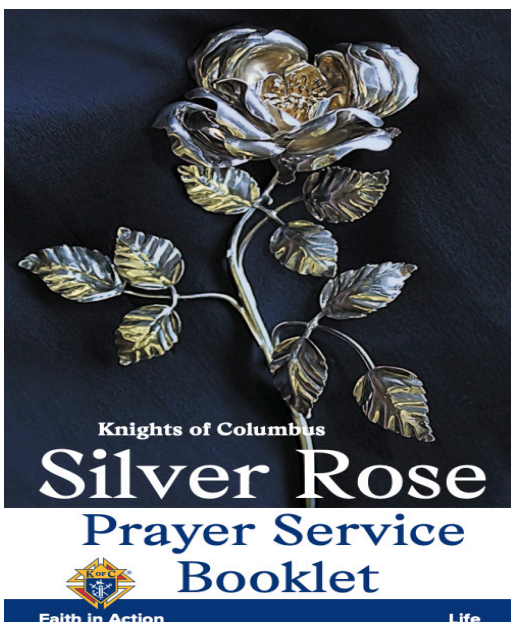

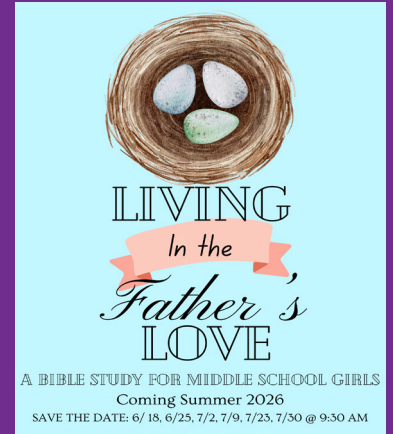

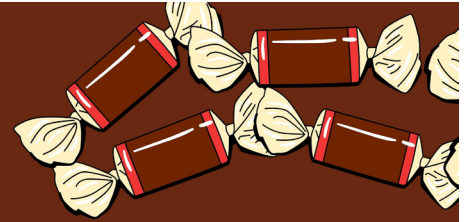

TOOTSIE ROLL DRIVE BENEFICIARY MONTHLY HIGHLIGHT



Every year the Knights of Columbus host the "Tootsie Roll Drive" for individuals with intellectual disabilities. Last year, with the help of Holy Cross and St. Peter Parishioners, we raised over \$30,000. These funds go directly back to our local community to support organizations that help those with intellectual disabilities. This week we want to highlight one of the organizations we support:

Association for Individual Development (AID) - Aurora
