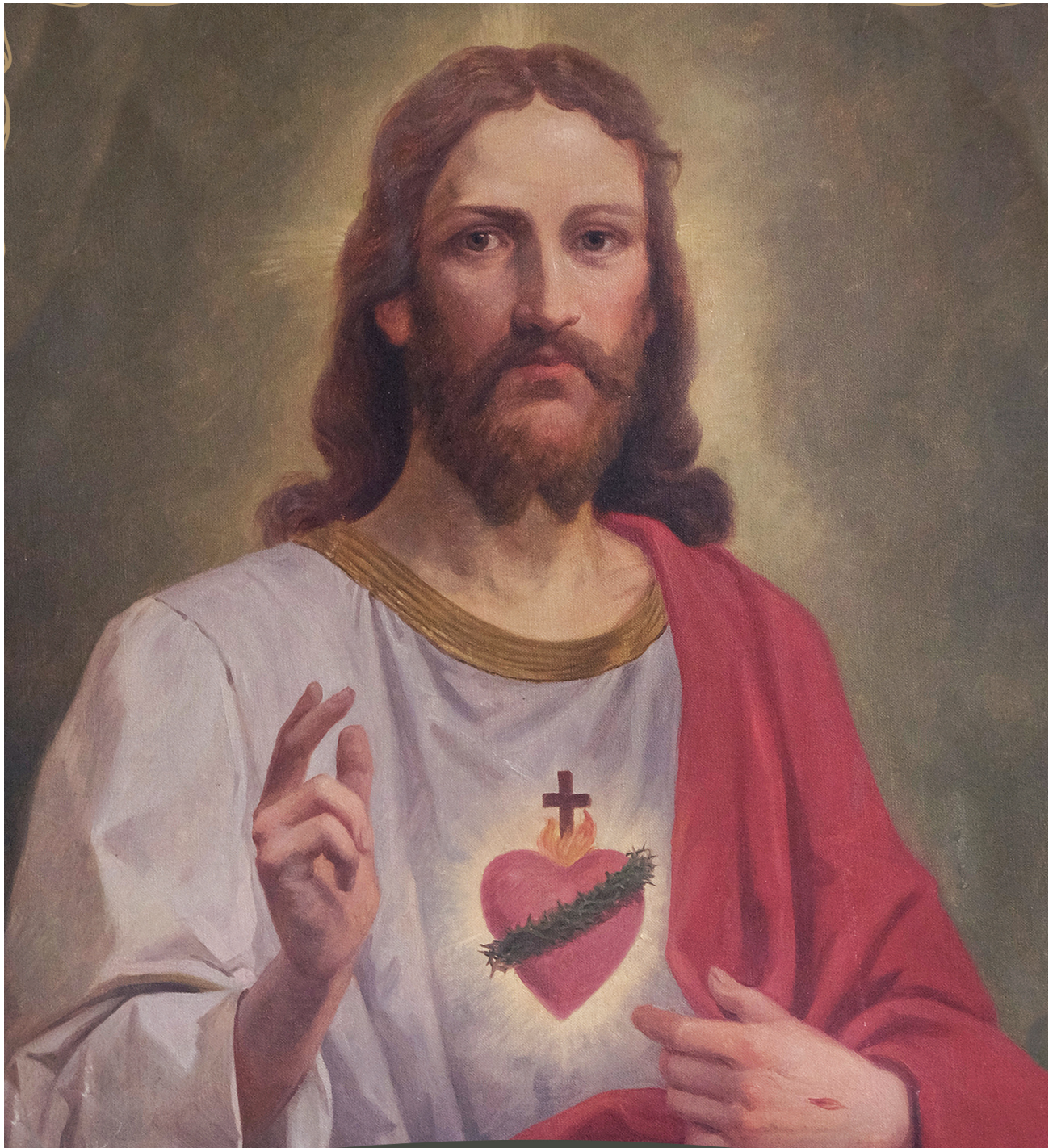

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Peter Family,

Next weekend marks the official launch of the You Will Be My Witnesses Campaign here at St. Peter Parish. This significant effort invites us to come together in faith to support both our parish needs (Establish an Evangelization Endowment, Improve Campus Door Security, Renovate Adoration Chapel, and Establish a Major Repair Endowment) and the broader mission of our diocesan family.

Through this campaign, we seek to strengthen the life of the Church in concrete ways, including:

Promoting Evangelization by:

- Increasing on-the-ground support within our parishes
- Enhancing our Catholic schools and expanding accessibility
- Growing bilingual outreach through the LiFE (Life and Family Evangelization) ministry
- Renovating the Bishop Lane Retreat Center

Supporting Parishes in Need:

- Assisting parishes with lower annual income through the Parish Opportunity Fund

Caring for Diocesan Facilities:

- Providing necessary maintenance to the Diocesan Administration Center, including HVAC replacement

The preparation phase for this campaign began in Fall 2024. Since then, Bishop Malloy, together with clergy and lay leaders, has been meeting with major donors to help lay a strong foundation for this effort.

As we now join other parishes in this second wave, we do so with gratitude and enthusiasm. Thanks to the generosity of those who have already participated, the campaign has secured more than \$251,000 in gifts and pledges. Now it is our turn to build upon that momentum. We will officially kick off the You Will Be My Witnesses Campaign at all Masses next weekend. It is a moment of great hope and opportunity for our parish and our entire diocesan family.

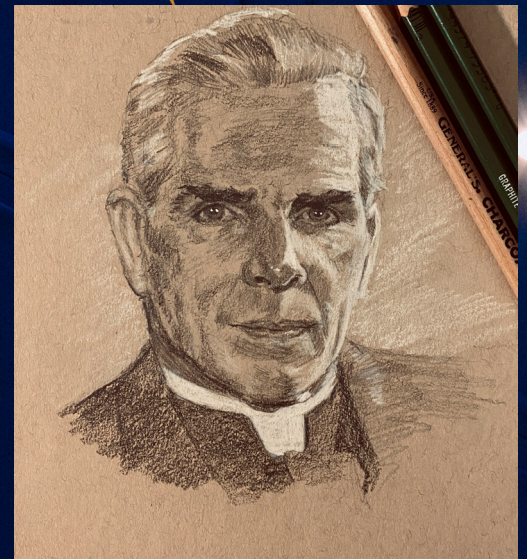
BEAUTY'S ARROW *Pulchritudo vulnera*

I remember being in seminary and watching a lot of videos from Fulton Sheen, I had never seen them growing up but, in a similar way to Bishop Barron, he has a very compelling yet simple way of communicating truth. And from how I hear him talked about, his ministry had a big impact on those who remember his broadcasts.

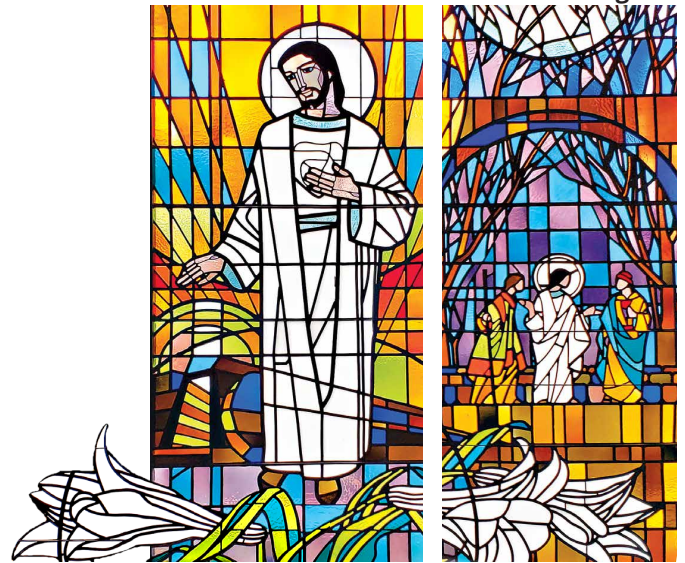

The Food Pantry is open from 8:00 am – 11am & 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm. Everyone is welcome with an ID.

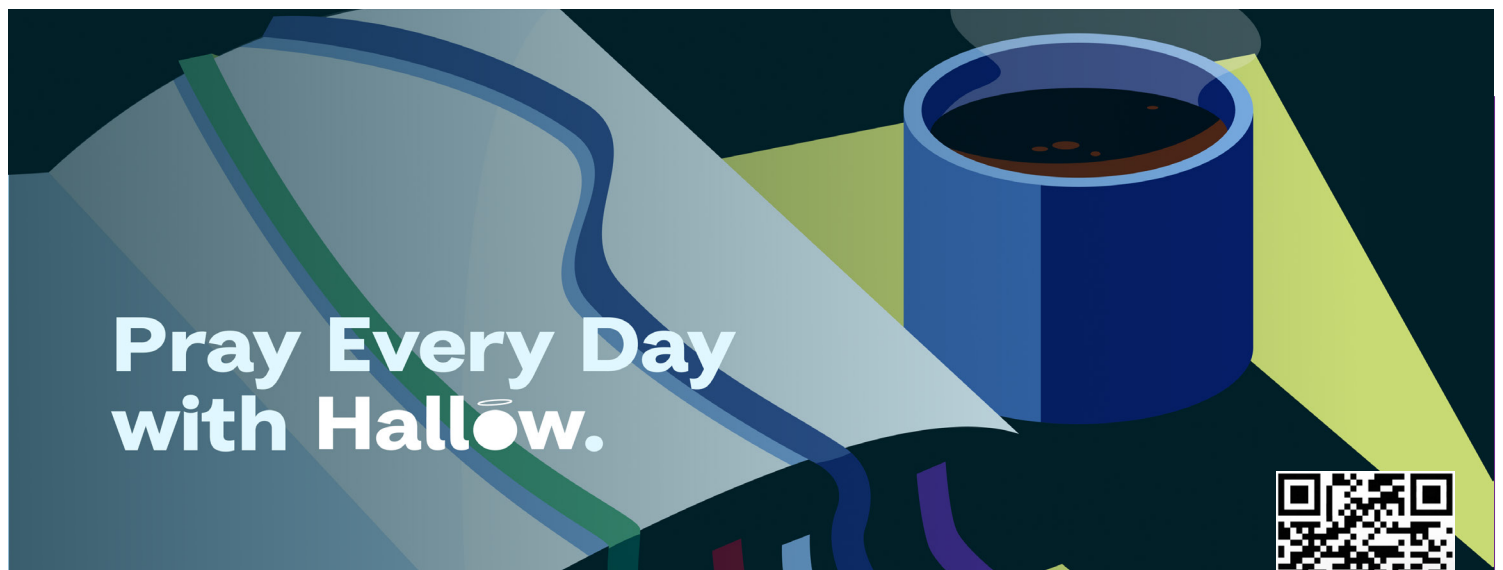

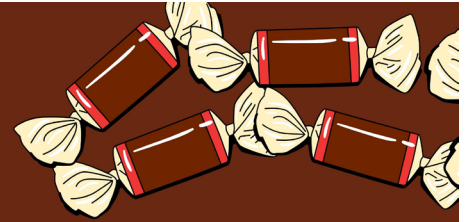

TOOTSIE ROLL DRIVE BENEFICIARY MONTHLY HIGHLIGHT



Every year the Knights of Columbus host the "Tootsie Roll Drive" for individuals with intellectual disabilities.
