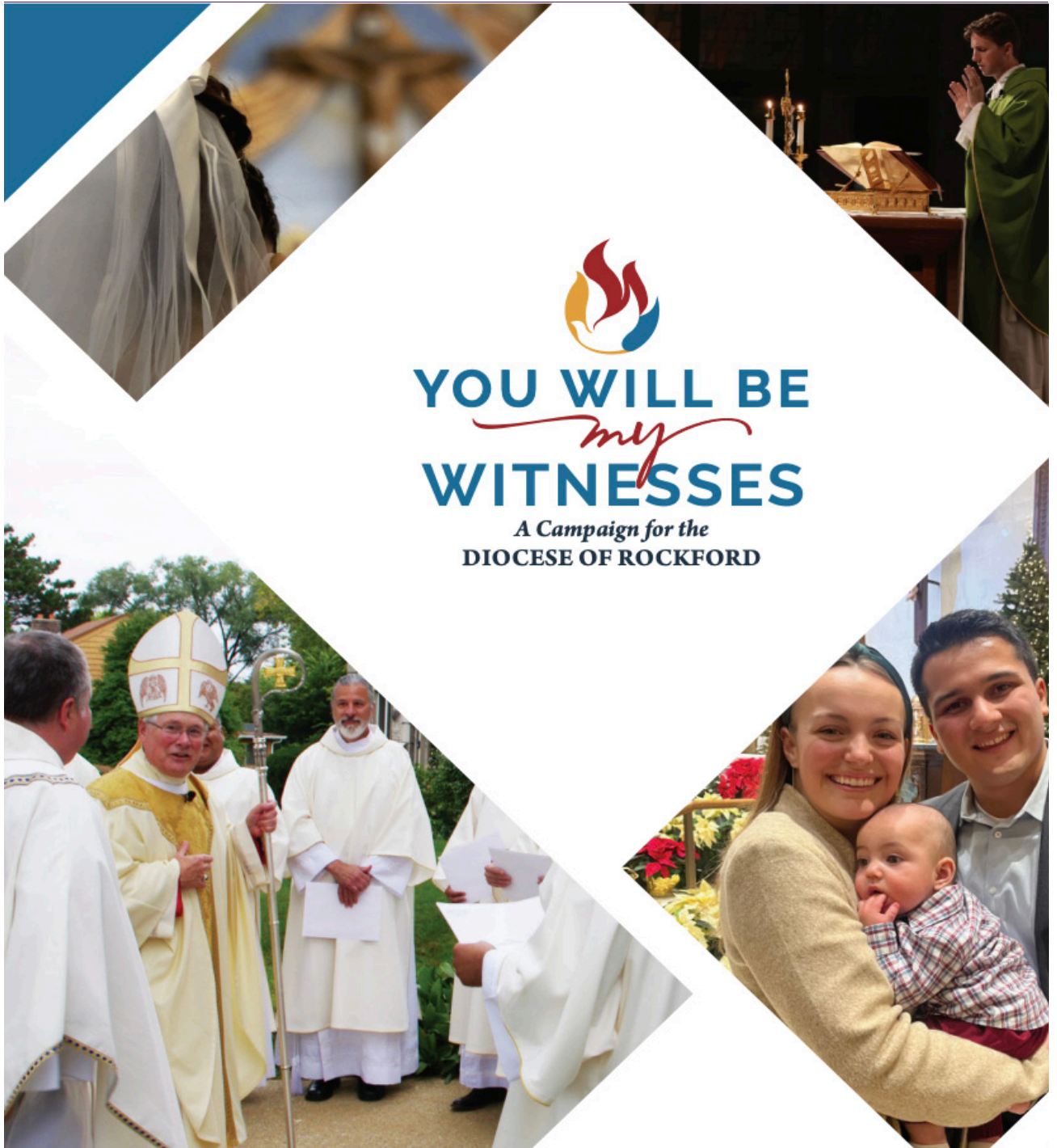

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Peter Family,

This weekend, as the Church celebrates the great feast of Pentecost, we hear again how the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles and sent them forth to proclaim the Gospel with courage, generosity, and faith. Pentecost reminds us that the Church is not meant to remain still. The Holy Spirit continually calls us outward—to renew, evangelize, and build up the Body of Christ for future generations. It is fitting, then, that this Pentecost weekend also marks the official launch of the You Will Be My Witnesses Campaign here at St. Peter Parish.

This campaign is an invitation for all of us to participate in the mission of the Church in a concrete and sacrificial way. Through this effort, we seek to strengthen both our parish and the wider diocesan family for years to come.

At St. Peter Parish, campaign funds will help us:

- Establish an Evangelization Endowment
- Improve campus door security
- Renovate the Adoration Chapel
- Establish a Major Repair Endowment

The campaign will also support important diocesan initiatives, including:

- Strengthening evangelization efforts throughout the diocese
- Supporting Catholic schools and increasing accessibility
- Expanding bilingual outreach through LiFE (Life and Family Evangelization)
- Assisting parishes in need through the Parish Opportunity Fund
- Renovating the Bishop Lane Retreat Center
- Addressing necessary maintenance at diocesan facilities

A capital campaign differs from our regular offertory and annual diocesan appeal. It is an extraordinary invitation over a limited period of time to make a sacrificial gift above and beyond our normal giving, each according to our means.

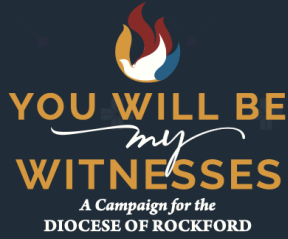
Most importantly, this campaign is not simply about buildings or finances. It is about mission. It is about creating opportunities for people to encounter Jesus Christ, strengthening our parish for future generations, and ensuring that the faith continues to flourish here at St. Peter and throughout the Diocese of Rockford.

STEWARDSHIP COMPARISON



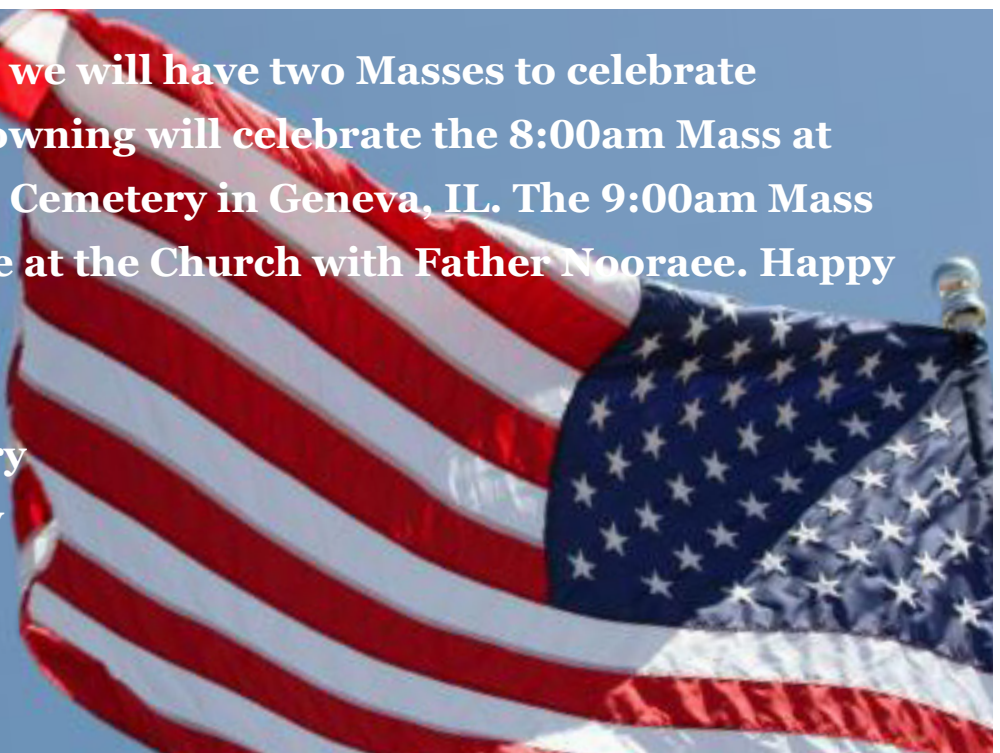

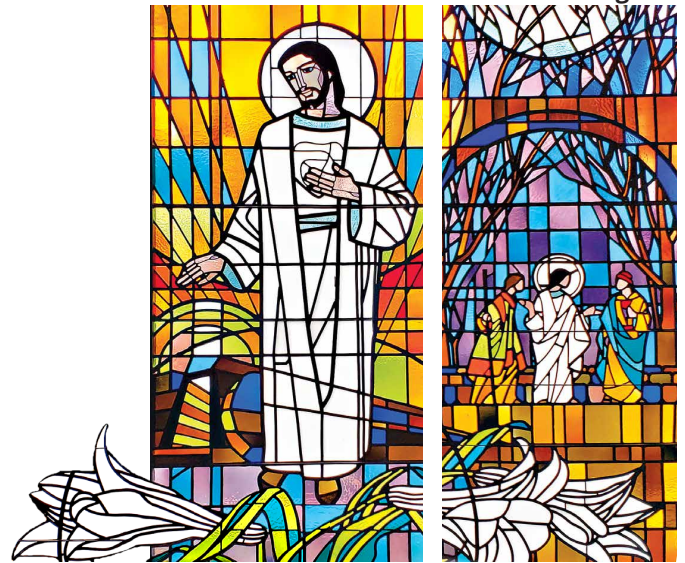

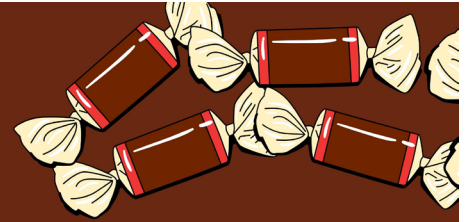
