# FROM THE PASTOR

*Dear St. Peter Family,*

This weekend the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ—Corpus Christi. It is a day when we pause to give thanks for the greatest gift Jesus left to His Church: Himself in the Holy Eucharist.

The Catechism teaches that the Eucharist is “the source and summit of the Christian life.” Everything we do as Catholics flows from the altar and leads us back to the altar. In the Eucharist, Jesus is not merely symbolically present; He is truly present—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. At every Mass, the sacrifice of Calvary is made present, and Christ feeds us with His very life.

Corpus Christi invites us to renew our faith in this great mystery. Do we approach Holy Communion with reverence and gratitude? Do we spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament? Do we recognize that the same Jesus who walked the roads of Galilee comes to us under the humble appearance of bread and wine?

The Eucharist is not only a gift to be received; it is a gift that transforms us. Having encountered Christ at Mass, we are sent forth to become His presence in the world through acts of charity, forgiveness, and service. The Lord who nourishes us at His table strengthens us to live as His disciples each day.

May this feast deepen our love for the Mass, renew our devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, and inspire us to echo the words of St. Thomas Aquinas: “I adore You devoutly, hidden God.” Jesus is here. Jesus is present. Jesus is waiting for us.

## BEAUTY'S ARROW *Pulchritudo vulnera*

### The Resurrection, Every Week, Everyday

As Catholics, we have a unique opportunity to encounter the living resurrected Christ in a very real way. Everytime we approach the altar for Mass, Christ is made present for us, his true and living presence in the Eucharist. The Mass doesn't make sense if Jesus wasn't raised from the dead. It also doesn't make sense if he didn't suffer and die. It's Christ's sacrifice that merited our salvation. The Mass makes that eternal exchange present in time. That's part of the reason the church asks us to put crucifixes in the church. There has been a trend to try and replace the figures of the crucified Jesus with figures of the resurrected Jesus in churches, but this is discouraged. Why? Because firstly, the Mass is first and foremost a sacrifice, Christ's sacrifice. It is by entering into death that he takes what should have been ours to give us what is his. But secondly, having an image of the resurrected Jesus would be redundant when the actual resurrected Christ is visibly present on the altar. We can see him, we can approach him, we can receive him. And it is this resurrected Jesus that we get to approach at every Mass.

The image for this week is one that I did for a brother seminarian years ago when he was being ordained a priest. I thought it apt, especially to illustrate Christ's presence in the Eucharist, through the Sacred Heart, but also that connection between his Resurrection and the Mass.

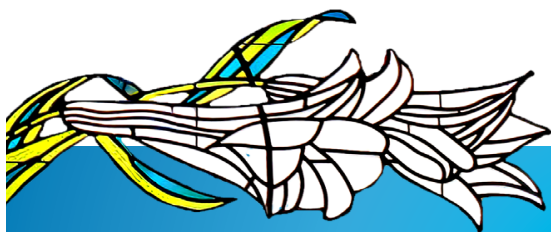

## HELP US KEEP OUR DIRECTORY UPDATED!

Please remember to update your address, contact info, children, etc in our directory! Our biggest reminder is for young adults to register as their own family! There is no magic answer to when a person becomes an “adult” within the Church. However, in order to establish their role as stewards of the Church, we recommend young adults register on their own once they have a job and a somewhat permanent address (not running back and forth from college campuses). For some, this is not an age, but a stage in life when they begin their own history of actively practicing their faith. For others, a logical age to be established independently is the age of 23.

Even if living at home with mom and dad, young adults should register with the parish. If no longer at home and living in another area, they should register with the parish where they live. Once registered on their own either at St. Peter or elsewhere, it is important to notify St. Peter so we can remove them as active members of their parents’ household.

This question of adulthood often comes up when a person is asked to be a sponsor for someone receiving a sacrament or wishes to be married in the Church, but has never established themselves beyond their parent’s family registration.

Once registered on their own, young adults who engage in stewardship of time, talent and treasure are able to build a record of sorts that they are actively participating in parish life. In essence, it helps them take ownership of their faith. It is important for young adults to be registered independently, as they are the future of our Church and society in general. It is another step in their journey of adulthood.

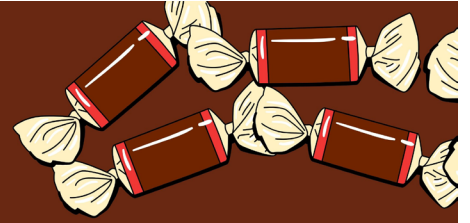

Every year the Knights of Columbus host the "Tootsie Roll Drive" for individuals with intellectual disabilities. Last year, with the help of Holy Cross and St. Peter Parishioners, we raised over \$30,000. These funds go directly back to our local community to support organizations that help those with intellectual disabilities. This week we want to highlight one of the organizations we support:

### Fox Valley Special Recreation Assoc. (FVSRA) – Aurora

- Formed in 1976 as an extension of multiple park districts in the Fox Valley
- Supported in its goals by the FVSR Foundation, a nonprofit, 501(c)(3) organization.
- FVSRA's mission is to empower people with disabilities to participate in therapeutic recreation and leisure activities, which are essential to a rich life
- 600+ programs: fitness to crafting, summer day camp to aquatics, sports to performing arts as well as Adult Day Programs
- Summer Day Camps (four days length, ages 5-22, appropriately grouped by age)
- Many programs/activities accessible by FVSRA bus transportation
- Programs designed by full-time, credentialed staff (Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialist (CTRS) and/or Certified Park and Recreation Professional (CPRP))
- Financial assistance available based on funding available
