FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Peter Family,

Over the coming weeks, I would like to invite you on a journey into one of the most important documents of the Second Vatican Council: *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy.

Mention the Second Vatican Council, and people often have strong opinions. Some remember changes that occurred in the Church after the Council. Others may wonder what Vatican II actually taught. Yet many Catholics have never had the opportunity to read the Council's documents themselves. What often surprises people is how beautiful, profound, and deeply rooted in the Church's tradition these documents truly are.

The very first document promulgated by the Council Fathers was *Sacrosanctum Concilium* on December 4, 1963. Why did the Council begin with the liturgy? Because the liturgy is the heart of the Church's life. Before discussing evangelization, ecumenism, religious life, or the Church's mission in the modern world, the Council first turned its attention to worship. The Council Fathers understood that everything the Church does flows from and returns to the worship of God.

The Constitution famously teaches that the liturgy is "the summit toward which the activity of the Church is directed; at the same time, it is the font from which all her power flows" (SC 10). In other words, the Mass is both the source and summit of the Christian life. Unfortunately, much of the discussion surrounding Vatican II has focused on what happened after the Council rather than what the Council actually taught. In this series, we will return to the document itself. Together we will discover the Council's vision for the liturgy: a vision centered on Christ, rooted in Scripture and Tradition, rich in beauty, reverence, and prayer, and calling every member of the faithful to a deeper participation in the mysteries we celebrate.

This series is not about revisiting old debates or taking sides. Rather, it is an invitation to encounter anew the greatest gift Christ has entrusted to His Church: the Holy Eucharist. Whether you have attended Mass faithfully for decades or are still growing in your understanding of the liturgy, I hope these reflections will help all of us pray more deeply, participate more fully, and appreciate the sacred mysteries celebrated at every Mass more profoundly.

The goal of the Council was not merely to change external practices but to draw the faithful into a fuller encounter with Jesus Christ. More than sixty years later, that invitation remains as relevant as ever. As we begin this journey together, let us ask the Holy Spirit to open our hearts to the treasures of the Church's liturgy and to help us rediscover the beauty of the Mass—the place where heaven touches earth and where Christ continues to sanctify His people.

HELP US KEEP OUR DIRECTORY UPDATED!

Please remember to update your address, contact info, children, etc in our directory! Our biggest reminder is for young adults to register as their own family! There is no magic answer to when a person becomes an “adult” within the Church. However, in order to establish their role as stewards of the Church, we recommend young adults register on their own once they have a job and a somewhat permanent address (not running back and forth from college campuses). For some, this is not an age, but a stage in life when they begin their own history of actively practicing their faith. For others, a logical age to be established independently is the age of 23.

Even if living at home with mom and dad, young adults should register with the parish. If no longer at home and living in another area, they should register with the parish where they live. Once registered on their own either at St. Peter or elsewhere, it is important to notify St. Peter so we can remove them as active members of their parents’ household.

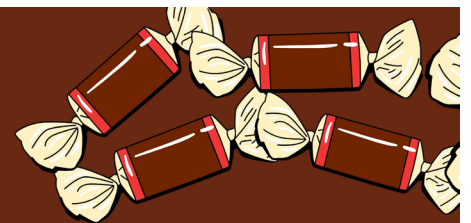
This question of adulthood often comes up when a person is asked to be a sponsor for someone receiving a sacrament or wishes to be married in the Church, but has never established themselves beyond their parent’s family registration.

Once registered on their own, young adults who engage in stewardship of time, talent and treasure are able to build a record of sorts that they are actively participating in parish life. In essence, it helps them take ownership of their faith. It is important for young adults to be registered independently, as they are the future of our Church and society in general. It is another step in their journey of adulthood.

TOOTSIE ROLL DRIVE BENEFICIARY MONTHLY HIGHLIGHT



Every year the Knights of Columbus host the “Tootsie Roll Drive” for individuals with intellectual disabilities. Last year, with the help of Holy Cross and St. Peter Parishioners, we raised over \$30,000. These funds go directly back to our local community to support organizations that help those with intellectual disabilities. This week we want to highlight one of the organizations we support:

Fox Valley Special Recreation Assoc. (FVSRA) – Aurora

- Formed in 1976 as an extension of multiple park districts in the Fox Valley
- Supported in its goals by the FVSR Foundation, a nonprofit, 501(c)(3) organization.
- FVSRA’s mission is to empower people with disabilities to participate in therapeutic recreation and leisure activities, which are essential to a rich life
- 600+ programs: fitness to crafting, summer day camp to aquatics, sports to performing arts as well as Adult Day Programs
- Summer Day Camps (four days length, ages 5-22, appropriately grouped by age)
- Many programs/activities accessible by FVSRA bus transportation
- Programs designed by full-time, credentialed staff (Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialist (CTRS) and/or Certified Park and Recreation Professional (CPRP))
- Financial assistance available based on funding available
