FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Peter Family,

As we continue our journey through *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, we have seen that the Mass is the source and summit of the Christian life and that true participation begins with offering our hearts to God. This week we turn to another foundational truth of our Catholic faith: **Jesus Christ is truly present every time we celebrate the Mass.**

When most Catholics hear the phrase “the Real Presence,” they immediately think of the Holy Eucharist—and rightly so. Through the power of the Holy Spirit and the words of consecration, the bread and wine become the true Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. This is the highest and most profound way Christ is present to His Church.

Yet the Second Vatican Council reminds us that the Lord’s presence in the liturgy is even richer than many of us realize.

Sacrosanctum Concilium teaches that Christ is present in several ways whenever the Church gathers for worship. He is present in the priest who acts in persona Christi—in the person of Christ the Head. He is present in His Word, for it is Christ Himself who speaks when the Scriptures are proclaimed. He is present in the assembled faithful, fulfilling His promise: “Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them.” Above all, He is present in the Eucharistic species in a unique and substantial way. This means that from the moment Mass begins until the final blessing, we are surrounded by the living presence of Christ.

When the priest greets us with, “The Lord be with you,” Christ welcomes His people.

When the Scriptures are proclaimed, Christ speaks to our hearts.

When the Gospel is announced, Christ reveals Himself anew.

When the altar is prepared, Christ invites us to unite our lives with His sacrifice.

When the bread and wine are consecrated, Christ becomes sacramentally present under the appearances of bread and wine.

When we receive Holy Communion, Christ gives Himself completely to us.

The Mass, then, is not simply something we attend. It is an encounter with a living Person.

Think about how differently we would approach Mass if we truly believed this with our whole hearts. Would we arrive hurried and distracted? Would we allow our minds to wander? Or would we come with joyful expectation, knowing that the Lord of heaven and earth desires to meet us?

The saints approached the Mass with this sense of wonder. They knew that every liturgy was a privileged encounter with Jesus. Their reverence did not come from mere custom but from faith. They believed that Christ was truly there—and that conviction transformed the way they prayed. Our own lives can be transformed in the same way. Before the priest ever reaches the altar, Christ is already waiting for us. He desires to speak to us, forgive us, strengthen us, and draw us more deeply into His divine life. Every Mass is an invitation to enter that relationship more fully.

As we continue this series, let us ask for the grace to recognize the many ways Christ makes Himself present in the liturgy. May we never lose our sense of awe before the mystery we celebrate each Sunday.

The greatest gift we bring to Mass is not our perfection, but our openness to the One who is already waiting to meet us.

Reflection Question:

Before Mass begins, do I consciously prepare myself to encounter Jesus Christ, believing that He is truly present and desires to speak to me, feed me, and transform my life?

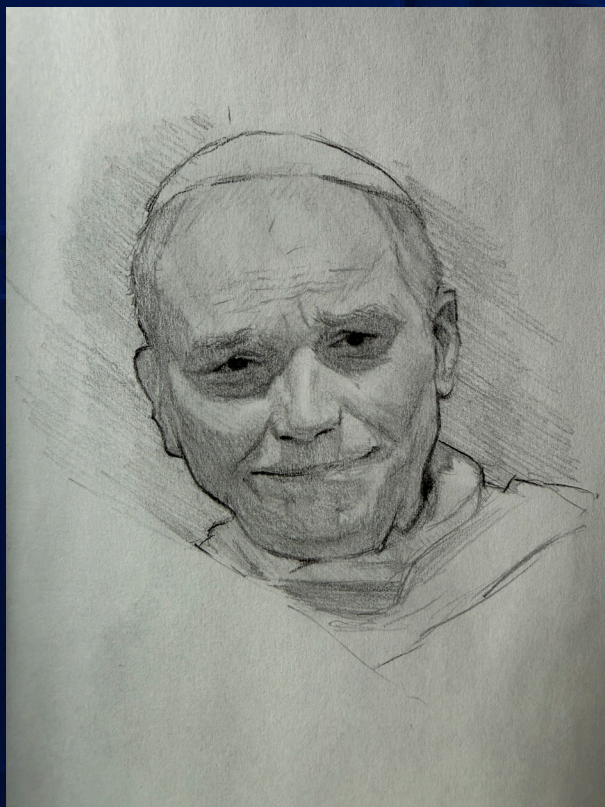

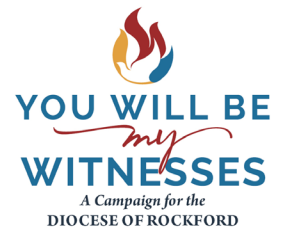

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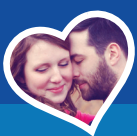
