FROM THE PASTOR

Dear St. Peter Family,

You Will Be My Witnesses Campaign Update

This weekend, July 18–19, our parish joins parishes across the Diocese of Rockford for Commitment Weekend for the *You Will Be My Witnesses* Campaign.

To date, our parish has raised **\$1,427,353** toward our goal of **\$2,016,878**, with participation at 6.6%. I am very grateful to everyone who has already made a sacrificial pledge to support this important effort. Your generosity is a beautiful witness to your love for Christ, His Church, and the mission entrusted to us.

At the same time, we still have work to do, and we need everyone's help. Our goal is not only to reach a financial number, but to invite every parish family to participate. Every gift matters. Every pledge is important. Each commitment, large or small, helps strengthen our parish and supports the broader mission of the Church throughout the Diocese of Rockford. Please help us reach our goal by maximizing participation.

One of the blessings of this campaign is that pledges are fulfilled over three years. This allows each family to consider a sacrificial gift that can be given gradually and faithfully. For example, a gift of **\$30 per month for three years** becomes a total pledge of **\$1,080**.

For those who have not yet made a pledge, I ask you to prayerfully consider doing so this weekend. Please make your pledge this weekend. Together, we can answer the call to be witnesses of Christ and help build up the life and mission of the Church for generations to come.

At Mass this weekend, I will ask each family to fill in a pledge card. If you have already given, please check one of two boxes: the one stating you have already given or the one making an additional gift. If you have not given, please choose one of the suggested gift plans on the form. If you are unable to give, please check the corresponding box and continue to pray for the capital campaign.

I would like to thank our Campaign Chairs, John Callahan and Randy Tavierne, for their diligent work and leadership. I am deeply grateful to all the volunteers who pledged to the campaign and took the time and effort to contact many parishioners to encourage participation. We could not have done it without you.

What Is a Tithe?

The word "tithe" simply means a tenth. Long before the coming of Christ, God's people set aside the first portion of what they had received — the first fruits of the harvest, the first of the flock — and returned it to the Lord. It was an act of trust, a way of saying that everything we have comes from God in the first place, and that the first and best of it belongs to Him. Scripture speaks of a tenth as the measure, and many Catholics still use that as a guide today: a portion given back before anything else is spent. Tithing teaches us to give from the top rather than from what happens to be left over, and in doing so it forms us in gratitude.

Why St. Peter Parish Tithes

With each weekly collection, our parish sets aside a portion of what you place in the basket or donate online and gives it away to charitable organizations in need. We do this because what is asked of each of us as individuals is also asked of us together as a parish. The same trust that moves a family to return a portion of its income to God should move a parish to return a portion of its offertory to the community beyond our own doors.

Until now, our parish tithe has been 1% of our weekly collection. Beginning July 1, 2026, we are increasing that tithe to 3%. This means that a greater share of your weekly offering will support Catholic charities and ministries here in our own community, across the Diocese of Rockford, and throughout the world. **Nothing is asked of you beyond what you already give.** We are simply committing, as a parish family, to hold a more open hand, trusting that the Lord will continue to provide for our own needs as He always has.

Our July 4 & 5 Tithe: \$1,087.65 Relief for Venezuela

On June 24, two powerful earthquakes struck Venezuela. Homes, water, food, and medical care were swept away for countless families, and the suffering continues. Bishop Malloy has asked the faithful of the Diocese of Rockford to stand with our brothers and sisters in this moment of great need. The Diocese has already sent \$25,000 to Catholic Relief Services, to provide emergency shelter, food, safe water, sanitation, and trauma care with particular attention to children, the elderly, and those with disabilities. In answer to the Bishop's request, our parish tithe of \$1,087.65 from the weekend collection of July 4 & 5 will be directed to this relief effort. 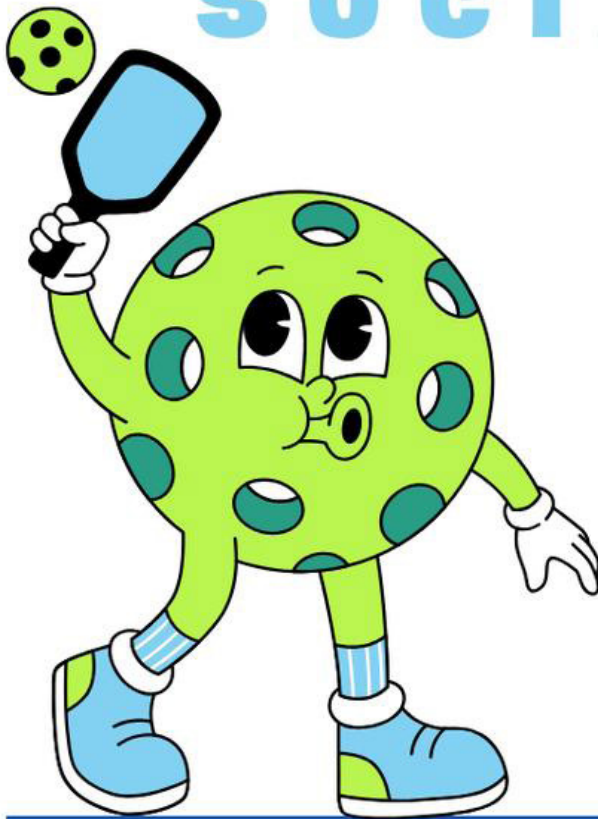
