Additional Information: The City of Leawood offers career development opportunities in which the employee could increase their experience, training, and pay. Summary of the Position: The Senior Accountant is responsible for accounts receivable, journal entries, requisitions and purchase orders, budget transactions, capital assets and vendor and ACH account information. The Senior Account assists in the preparation of the monthly and annual financial statements performed in accordance with general instructions following accepted general accounting procedures, applicable laws and City policies under the supervision of the Finance Manager.

Minimum Requirements: Must possess a minimum of an Associates' Degree with emphasis in accounting from an accredited higher education institution with four (4) years of accounting experience. OR A Bachelors' Degree in accounting or a related field with degree from an accredited higher education institution plus two (2) years of accounting experience. Equivalent experience includes at least six (6) years of progressively responsible accounting duties.
