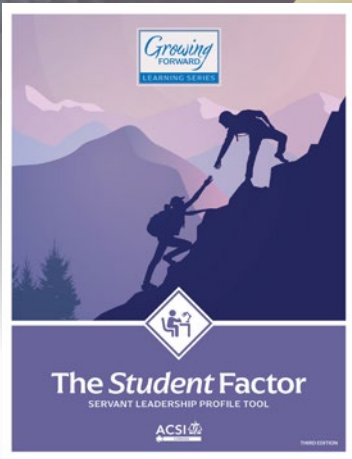


The 8 P's is a growing process for you to consider to help grow forward your school, staff, board, students, parents, and community.

1. **PICTURE** — Just as a gardener envisions the beauty of the garden, you'll create a mental picture of your ideal life, aligning your values, passions, and strengths. However, cultivating a life of purpose will require more than just envisioning a beautiful life—it will demand intentional action and perseverance.
2. **PLAN** — A gardener plans the layout of the garden, considering the needs of each plant. Similarly, you'll plan your life, setting goals and priorities that align with your mission. But a plan is only as good as the effort put into executing it, and growing forward will require flexibility and adaptability.
3. **PLOW** — Before planting, a gardener must plow the soil to break up clods and prepare the ground. You'll plow through obstacles, breaking free from limitations and clearing the way for growth. Yet, the hardest work often lies ahead, and cultivating a life of purpose will require ongoing effort to maintain momentum.
4. **PLANT** — With the soil prepared, a gardener plants seeds, nurturing them until they sprout. You'll plant dreams, hopes, and aspirations, trusting God to bring them to fruition. Nevertheless, growth is often slow and unpredictable, and developing a strategy to grow forward will demand patience and trust.
5. **PROTECT** — A gardener protects the plants from harm, providing shelter and care. You'll protect your time, energy, and resources, prioritizing what's truly important. However, protection is not the same as isolation, and cultivating a life of purpose will require strategic engagement with the world around you.
6. **PRUNE** — Pruning helps plants grow stronger and more fruitful. You'll prune away distractions, eliminating what's unnecessary and focusing on what brings life and growth. Nonetheless, pruning is an ongoing process, and growing forward will require regular evaluation and adjustment.
7. **POLLINATE** — Bees and butterflies pollinate flowers, allowing them to reproduce. You'll pollinate relationships, nurturing connections that bring joy, support, and growth. Still, pollination is a reciprocal process, and cultivating a life of purpose will involve both giving and receiving.
8. **PROPAGATE** — A gardener propagates new plants, sharing the bounty with others. You'll propagate hope, spreading love, kindness, and inspiration to those around you. Yet, propagation is not just about spreading goodness, but also about creating a lasting legacy that will continue to inspire and uplift others.

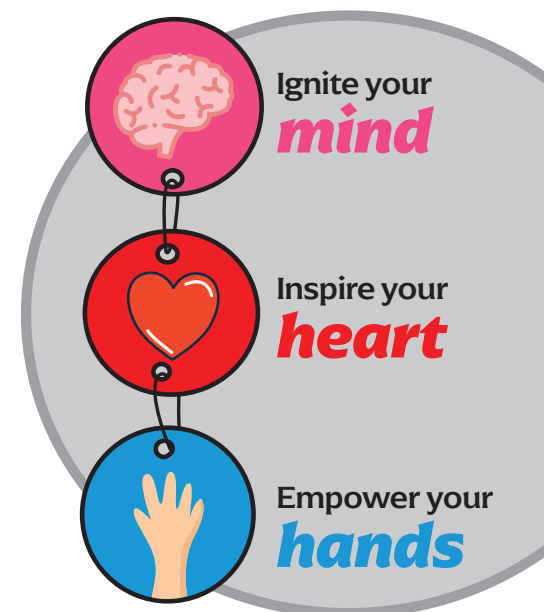

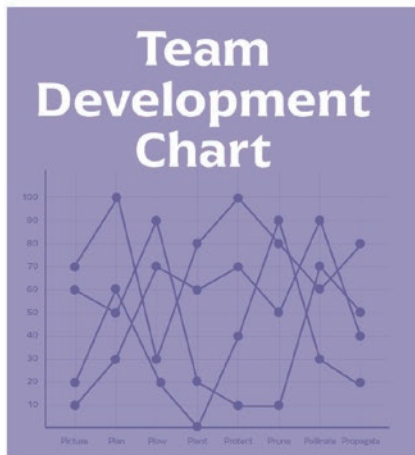
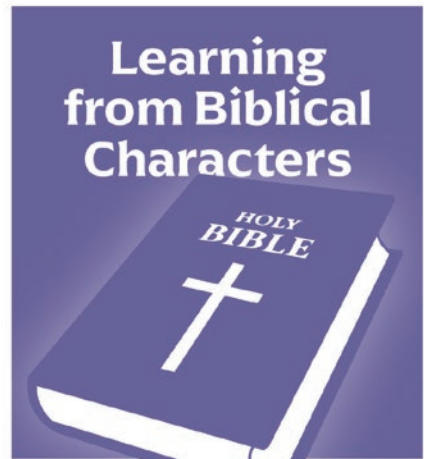

Seeking Alternatives

A 2025 market-research poll of school parents found 64% say K–12 education is headed in the wrong direction. When asked what they would choose if they could:

36%	Private School
14%	Homeschool
10%	Charter Schools
40%	Public Schools

Parents cite growing dissatisfaction with public school direction, interest in more faith- or values-based learning, and desire for smaller, more personalized settings.

The pandemic accelerated interest in homeschooling and private options, with families reporting higher satisfaction among those who made the switch.

Parents have been looking for new alternative pathways and are willing to pay more for it to align education with their beliefs and to get more individualized attention for their children.

Measure Biblical Literacy To Inform Instruction

ACSI announces the ACSI Bible Assessment (ABA) as a stand-alone, standardized test. In the past the ABA was included with the TerraNova 3, ACSI Edition achievement test. This ABA was developed by ACSI and is now available as an online test with a paper/pencil option through the testing and scoring platform.



Grades K–12

The ABA is different from textbook/teacher made tests. It is a standardized assessment built upon a scope and sequence that reflects a broad range of Bible curriculum/textbooks and the input of Bible instruction experts. Its purpose is to provide a snapshot of students' knowledge, understanding, and life application of Scripture.

The test is also designed to help those educators to know the strengths of their Bible instructional program and to see if the students have learned more than Bible facts. It was in response to these needs that ACSI developed this useful assessment tool.

The set of ABA items included at each grade level are developed from two key perspectives:

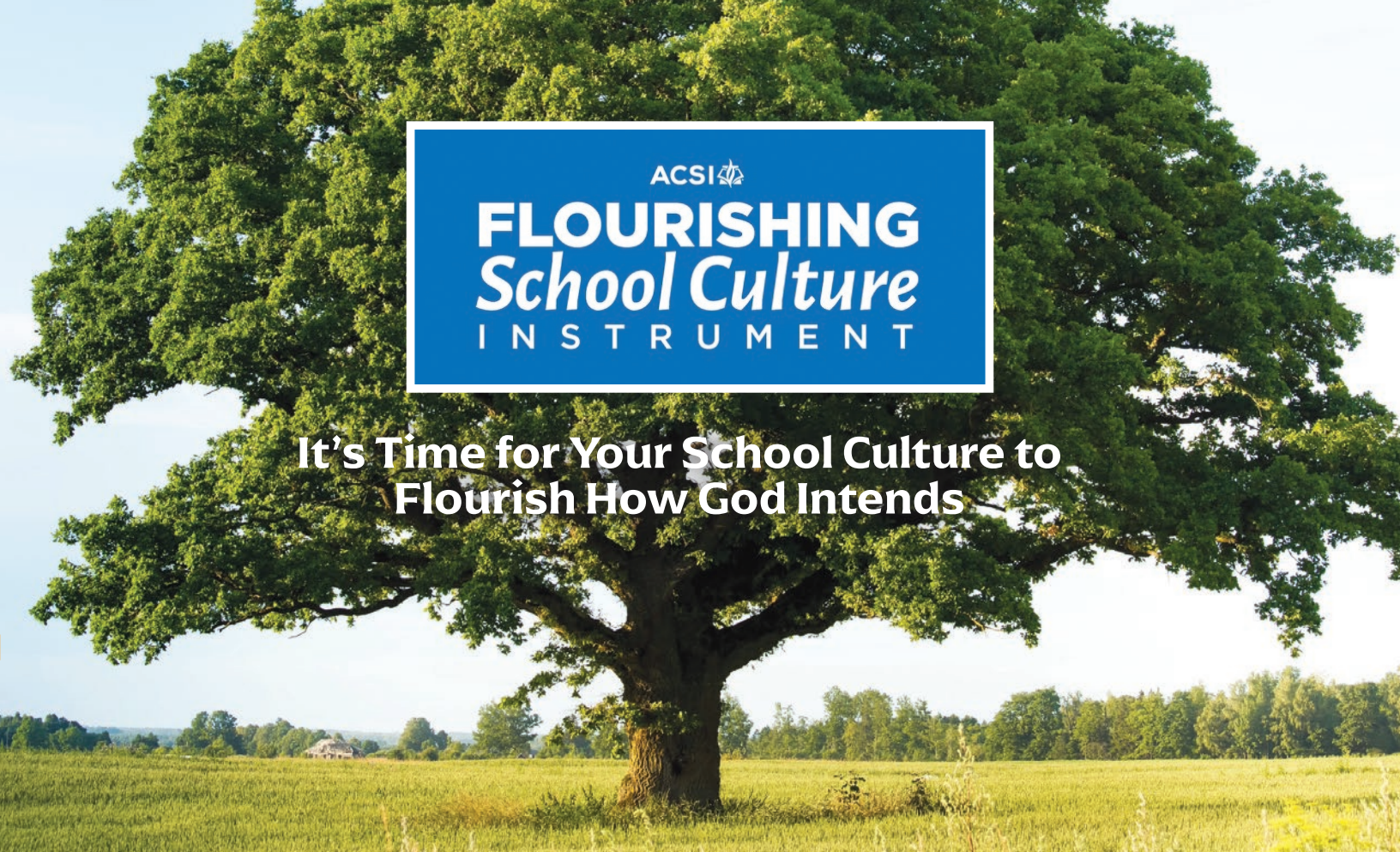
Content Clusters: Each item addresses a core element of a strong Bible curriculum, such as knowledge of creation, Christ, Old and New Testament Bible stories, Bible organization and structure, the Church, and Christian living. Content Clusters vary by grade level.

Process Clusters: Each item also assesses either Knowledge (recall, recognition), Comprehension (demonstration of understanding), or Application (purposeful use or relevance) of biblical information. Process Clusters are the same across all grade levels.

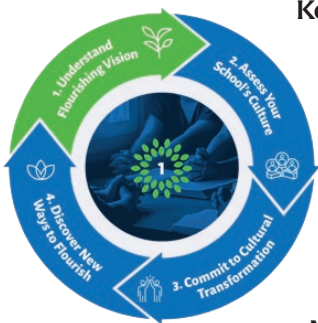

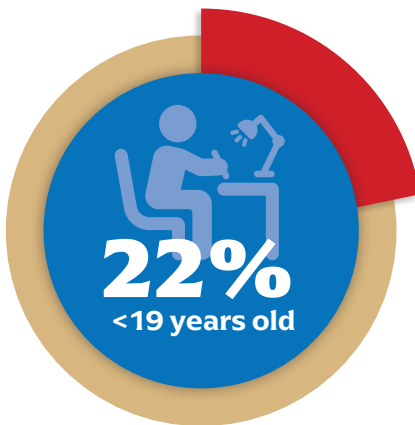

Christian Education Matters

Investing in the faith of young people isn't just a spiritual priority—it shows up in research as a driver of stronger academics, character, and civic life, which matters for Canada's future:

- **2023 review in *Religions*:** higher levels of religious faith are linked to positive youth outcomes: greater self-control, lower anxiety and delinquency, and stronger social connection.
- **2019 thesis on Christian high-school students:** participation in faith-based programs correlates with higher spiritual maturity after graduation and a lasting positive view of those programs.
- **Cardus Education Survey (cited in 2025 coverage):** students in faith-based schools tend to outperform peers on academic metrics and also develop leadership and responsibility.



Why It Matters...

Canada has about 7.8 million youth under 19 years old (2021 Census). As that cohort shapes workplaces, communities, and public life, the qualities nurtured in Christian education—ethical decision-making, service orientation, and a coherent worldview—help produce engaged citizens.

Youth theology research also emphasizes that when young people are treated as active participants in faith (not just passive recipients), they build critical thinking and a sense of purpose that translates into community involvement.

In short, Christian education provides both academic support and a framework for moral formation. Those combined effects equip young Canadians—our future leaders—to navigate complexity, contribute to community, and sustain the values that underpin a healthy society.

Teaching *Beyond* the Lesson Plan

10 Practices that Matter More than Grades

By Dr. Derrick Mueller

In every Christian classroom there are students who arrive with stories they never say out loud—stories of being moved, judged, labeled, or left. Some have heard, in words or in silence, “you can’t.” And some will go on to do exactly what they were told they couldn’t... because one adult in a school chose to stay, to see them, and to believe in them.

As Christian educators we are not only delivering curriculum. We are stewarding image-bearers. We are planting seeds we may never see harvested. The following 10 practices are not theory; they are the habits of teachers whose presence became ministry, whose classrooms became places of grace.

Key Verse: *“Let us not grow weary in doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.”*
— Galatians 6:9

1. Your Words Stay With Them

Students remember what we say, even the comments we forget by the end of the day. A careless word can wound for years, but a kind word can become the reason a student keeps trying. In a Christian school, our words carry the weight of our witness. Speak as if they will carry your words forever, because they often do.

2. “Slow” Often Means “Different”

Learning disabilities and language struggles are not signs of low intelligence, only different ways of thinking and processing. What makes school hard today may become a student’s greatest strength tomorrow, because finding another way around a problem builds creativity and resilience. God gifts His children diversely. Look for their strength, not just their struggle.

3. Belonging Comes First

Students don't get their lives together and then find community; they find a team, a club, a group that accepts them, and then they begin to grow. The student who lingers after class or practice is often looking for family, not just an activity. In our schools, belonging is a doorway to discipleship. Let them in.

4. Time Beats Judgment

Judging a student only labels them, but spending time with them changes them. We do not have to fix a child's whole life to make an eternal difference; we only have to be the person who notices and doesn't walk away. Ten minutes after class can matter more than any lesson plan.

5. You're Teaching a Future Adult

The difficult child in front of you today may be the teacher, pastor, parent, or leader of tomorrow. One day they may stand in front of others and say, "I was you," because someone once believed in them. Teach the adult they will become, not just the child you see now.

6. Discipline Builds Confidence

Sports, music, art, and routines give students a way to succeed when academics feel like failure. Structure and practice teach them they can do hard things, and that sense of competence builds identity. Give them something they can master with their hands and heart, not just their grades.

7. Not Everyone Shows Smart the Same Way

Some students cannot show what they know on

a test or essay, but they can build it, draw it, speak it, move it, or serve it. When one way of expressing intelligence is closed to them, offer another. Intelligence is wider than the curriculum, and gifting is wider than the report card.

8. Free Things Matter Most

For students with no money, free clubs and events are not "extra"—they are the only door they can walk through. A free meal after school, a free trip, a free place to belong can be the difference between being included and being invisible. In Christian community, what costs nothing can mean everything.

9. See the Child, Not the Label

Labels like "learning disabled," "low math," or "behavior problem" are notes for adults, but they become identity for children. A label may describe a challenge, but it must never decide a future. Look past the file and see the person God is forming.

10. Staying Is Teaching

Showing up, remembering names, asking again next week—this is how students learn they matter. For children who have been left, consistency is the lesson. Be the adult who stays, because that is the lesson they will never forget.

Conclusion: Faithful in the Hidden Work

We may never see the harvest. We may not be there when the student we encouraged becomes the speaker, the parent, or the mentor who breaks a cycle in their family. But the seed we plant by staying, by speaking life, by giving them a place to belong in Christ—that seed grows.

A Personal Note

The principles above are not abstract to me. I came from a broken home, moved through foster families, and struggled with dyslexia at a time when schools had few strategies to help. I was confused, behind, and often looked down on by my peers.

Yet teachers and church leaders chose to invest in me anyway. Because they stayed, lived me in their actions and invested in me I learned like them to see, truly see others and what they could become—and now I spend my life trying to do the same. There is hope for the students of tomorrow, because there was hope for me.

The Kingdom is full of adults who remember one teacher.

- ♦ Be that teacher.
- ♦ Keep showing up.
- ♦ Keep believing.
- ♦ Keep staying.

I truly believe, because you have experienced it, that one day someone will stand in front of a room and say, "I am here because a teacher didn't give up on me."

And by God's grace, that teacher will be you.

Saved by grace—and by teachers who stayed.

Be a Difference Maker

As I reflect on our shared calling in Christian education, I keep coming back to the life of Stephen—a powerful example of someone who truly lived as a difference maker.

In Acts 6–7, Stephen wasn't in what many would consider a prominent role, yet his impact was extraordinary. He was full of faith, wisdom, and the Holy Spirit. He served faithfully, spoke truth with courage, and trusted God no matter the cost. Stephen reminds us that being a difference maker isn't about title or position—it's about a heart fully surrendered to God.

And that's the opportunity in front of each of us every day—to be a difference maker right where God has placed us. In our classrooms, in our offices, and around our board tables, the small things we do faithfully can have a lasting impact.

Here are five qualities I see in every *difference maker* across our schools:

1. Christ-Centered Vision

A *difference maker* keeps Jesus at the center of it all—not just in what we say, but in how we live and lead every day. It shows up in the choices we make, the priorities we set, and the example we model for others.

2. Servant Leadership

A *difference maker* leads by serving, choosing humility, kindness, and a genuine care for others. It's about lifting people up, being present, and creating space for others to thrive.

3. Commitment to Excellence

A *difference maker* gives their best, not for recognition, but as an act of worship. It's a daily commitment to grow, improve, and steward well the responsibility we've been given.

4. Relational Intentionality

A *difference maker* takes time for people, knowing that relationships are where real impact happens. A listening ear, a word of encouragement, or a moment of care can make all the difference.

5. Courageous Faith

A *difference maker* trusts God even when it's not easy, standing firm in truth and stepping forward with confidence. It's about choosing faith over fear and believing God is at work in every situation.

As we move forward together, my encouragement is simple: keep showing up, keep trusting God, and keep being a difference maker. What you do matters more than you may ever fully see, and the impact will last far beyond today.

MOSES (Exodus 3–14)

A *difference maker* who led the Israelites out of slavery, trusting God to deliver His people against overwhelming odds.

ESTHER (Esther 4–7)

A *difference maker* who courageously risked her life to save her people, recognizing she was placed “for such a time as this.”

DAVID (1 Samuel 16–17)

A *difference maker* who, as a young shepherd, defeated Goliath through faith, inspiring a nation to trust in God.

DEBORAH (Judges 4–5)

A *difference maker* who led with wisdom and courage as a prophet and judge, guiding Israel to victory.

PAUL (Acts 9; 13–28)

A *difference maker* who spread the Gospel across the Roman world, transforming countless lives through his missionary journeys.

MARY, the mother of Jesus (Luke 1–2)

A *difference maker* who responded in humble obedience to God's calling, playing a central role in His redemptive plan.

PETER (Matthew 14:22–33; Acts 2)

A *difference maker* who grew from an impulsive follower to a bold leader, helping establish the early Church.

PRISCILLA (Acts 18:24–26)

A *difference maker* who, alongside her husband, helped disciple and teach others more accurately in the faith.

JOSEPH (Genesis 37–50)
