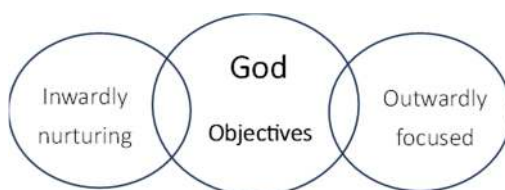

150 years of Mothers Union - 2026 is a momentous year for MU worldwide as we celebrate across the world. Praise God that Mary Sumner answered God's call to found Mothers Union in 1876. Prompted by reliving the difficulties of motherhood as she witnessed her daughter's struggles, Mary Sumner used her networks to begin an organisation to support mothers across all social classes (an important distinction at that time). When thinking about attracting new members, we could learn from Mary's use of her networks by sharing the great work of MU with our friends and others, inviting them to come to MU events.

Since Mary Sumner's time MU has grown exponentially as the importance of "winning homes for Christ" through care for women, girls and families has been recognised throughout the Anglican Church worldwide. As MU members here in Australia, I commend you for all you do in continuing to carry out that work in our parishes and local communities.



Our MU Framework with God at the centre of our lives and Jesus as our example guiding MU actions, our five objectives give us focus and direction. Listening to your diocesan Presidents as they reported on the MU work being undertaken in each diocese at Australia Council last October, I rejoiced in all that you had done and are doing for God's Kingdom through MU.

My prayer is that you all can participate in some way in a celebration of MU's 150 anniversary, giving thanks to God for the blessings you have received through MU and looking forward to our future with hope.
