## From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Saint Liborius and Saint Boniface,

### **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity Sunday**

We may think of the dogma of the Most Holy Trinity by the famous story of the shamrock or Saint Augustine walking on the beach; however, the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity stands at the very core of Catholic belief. At every Mass, we not only begin and end with the invocation of the Most Holy Trinity (Sign of the cross and Final Blessing) but each prayer is made to the Father in the Son and the Holy Spirit.

We believe something specific about God contained in the earliest dogmatic pronouncements of the Church. We believe in one God in three persons. We are not polytheists who believed in many gods like the Greeks, Romans and most of the ancient religions. We believe in one God just as the Jewish people do. The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob revealed Himself to His chosen people as a personal God, a God who is in a relationship of love with His human creatures. When Jesus Christ became incarnate, He revealed even more clearly God's identity. Our God is Triune, One God in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

In fact, the Dogma of the Holy Trinity helps us to understand that love creates life. Since our God is a loving personal God, He creates. Love and Life are inextricably linked. God creates because He is love and life is essential to love. We try to separate love and life...have one without the other, but love is always creative and life is the essential prerequisite of love. This is the reason why, of all the ways God could have chosen to bring a new human life into the world, He chose that a new human life should come into the world in a relationship of love. This is the foundation and the reason our Church so strongly defends the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony and the reason why she advocates for the sanctity of every human life.

This understanding is not some arbitrary positive law made up by some guys in pointy hats. Our Catholic understanding of the way people love and the reason human life is sacred finds its foundation in the most basic Christian Dogma of the Most Holy Trinity and the essential link between God's creative will and love.

Happy Holy Trinity Day!

# Sacraments

## **Sacrament of Baptism**

All parents asking for their children to be baptized must attend a Baptismal Prep class. Classes are held on the third Thursday of every month at 6:30 p.m. @ St. Liborius in the Church, with a reminder notice in the parish bulletin. If a child has already been baptized here no need to attend class again.

Please register for the class by calling the St. Liborius Parish Office at 708-754-1363. Godparents are also encouraged to attend the class. Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays immediately following the 10:30am Mass. Families and attendees of the Baptism are encouraged to attend Mass as the Baptisms will commence immediately after Mass.

## **Sacrament of Marriage**

Marriage preparation must begin a minimum of six months prior to the actual wedding date. Contact the parish office—St. Liborius (708-754-1363) or St. Boniface (708-534-9682) to begin the process.

## **Anointing of the Sick**

Anointing of the Sick is the sacrament that is received by those who are ill or suffering. By the sacred anointing and the prayer of the priest, the whole Church commends those who are sick to Christ.

Due to the Privacy Act, hospitals can no longer inform us when a parishioner is admitted to the hospital. A close relative needs to call either Parish Office—St. Liborius (708-754-1363) or St. Boniface (708-534-9682) to request an anointing.

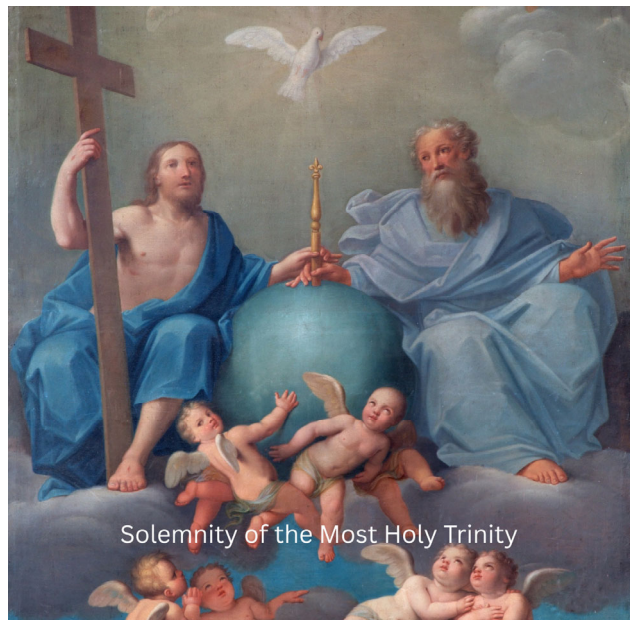
