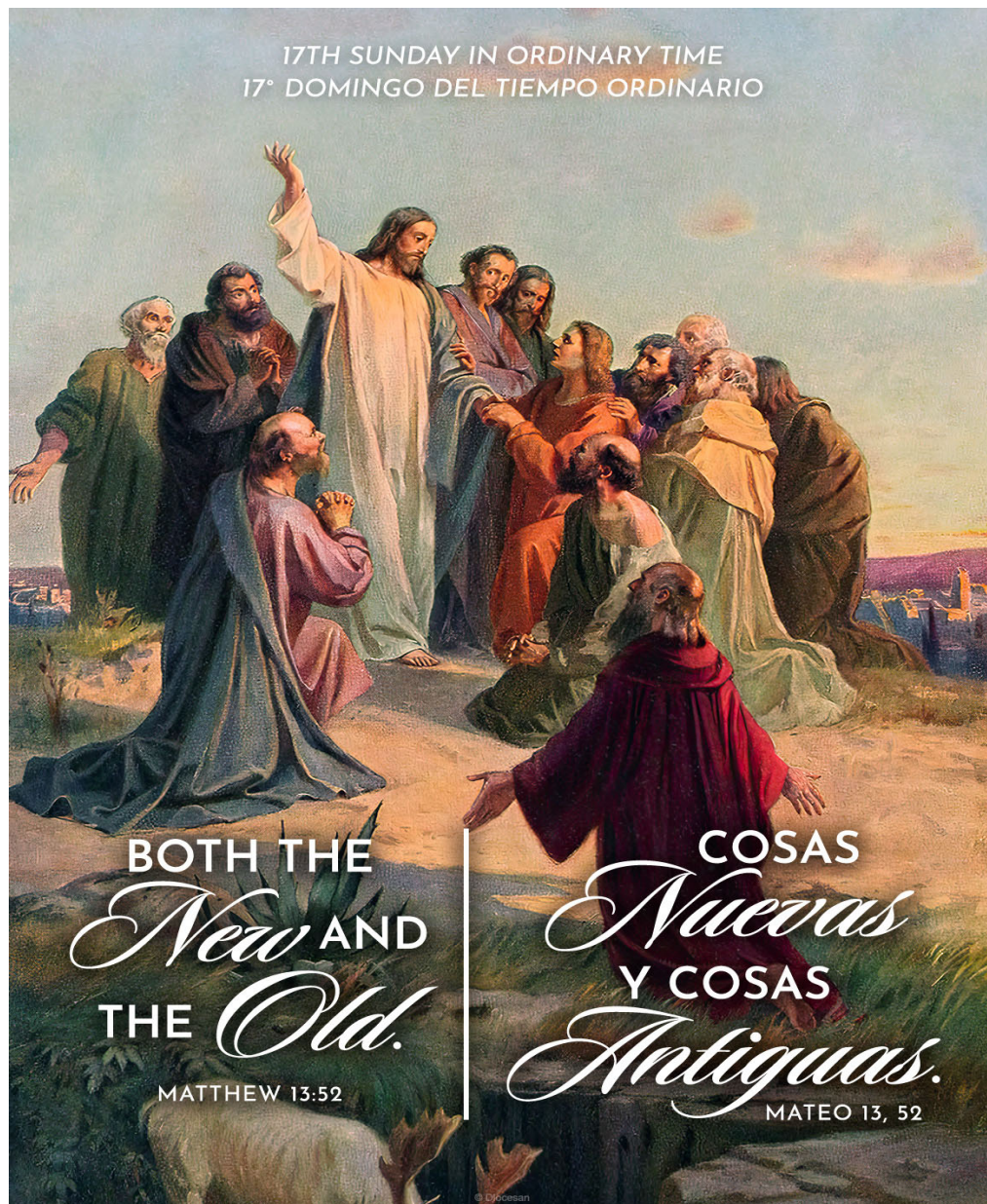

From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Saint Liborius parish and Saint Boniface church,

Saint Liborius Scholarship Program

Thank you to all those who use their envelopes to support the Saint Liborius Scholarship fund which offers a \$1000 scholarship to active parishioners of Saint Liborius parish and Saint Boniface church. At present, our parish is supporting 16 students who are parishioners in their commitment to send their children either to our Catholic grade school or to a Catholic High School. Thank you to all those who support our scholarship fund.

Fundraising Efforts for MTCA

Some of our school families made the trek up north to Saints Peter and Paul parish in Naperville to assist in raising money to cover the budget deficit at MTCA and raise money for our Mother Teresa Tuition Assistance Fund. Our school has a significant budget deficit due to her low enrollment, an enrollment that has been declining for years.

We have been working hard to turn things around at MTCA. Last year, our school had the largest percent increase in standardized test scores of any school in the Diocese of Joliet. We have increased our on-line presence and outreach to our local communities. We even have a brand new sign here on Steger road thanks to the assistance of our new mayor in Steger. Our new principal at MTCA, Felice Hybert, sent her children to MTCA and brings a great deal of expertise and personal investment to make MTCA flourish.

Saints Peter and Paul in Naperville has already made a donation of \$100,000 to MTCA to allow our school to continue one more year and they are still tabulating the additional donations that will go to the MTCA Tuition Assistance Fund. This fund allows those with a financial need to attend our Catholic School and was begun just this year with a generous donation of \$12,000 from an anonymous donor from our parish. This fund allows us to offer scholarships focused on those from our area and offers scholarships on top of those offered from the CEF.

We have also received generous donations from Saint Anne in Oswego (\$50,000) and Saint Anthony in Frankfort (\$50,000). We are humbled by the commitment of parishioners who have no specific association with our parish to support our schools out of the pure generosity of their hearts. Our school and parish owe them a debt of gratitude.

Sacrament of Baptism

All parents asking for their children to be baptized must attend a Baptismal Prep class. Classes are held on the third Thursday of every month at 6:30 p.m. @ St. Liborius in the Church, with a reminder notice in the parish bulletin. If a child has already been baptized here no need to attend class again.

Please register for the class by calling the St. Liborius Parish Office at 708-754-1363. Godparents are also encouraged to attend the class. Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays immediately following the 10:30am Mass. Families and attendees of the Baptism are encouraged to attend Mass as the Baptisms will commence immediately after Mass.

Sacrament of Marriage

Marriage preparation must begin a minimum of six months prior to the actual wedding date. Contact the parish office—St. Liborius (708-754-1363) or St. Boniface (708-534-9682) to begin the process.

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the Sick is the sacrament that is received by those who are ill or suffering. By the sacred anointing and the prayer of the priest, the whole Church commends those who are sick to Christ.

Due to the Privacy Act, hospitals can no longer inform us when a parishioner is admitted to the hospital. A close relative needs to call either Parish Office—St. Liborius (708-754-1363) or St. Boniface (708-534-9682) to request an anointing.
