A Backward Glance #4 – "Why November?" by Brian Jobb

(An occasional series sharing thoughts, facts and curiosities from our church history)

According to the earliest records that can be found, in month of July, 1814, the Methodist Church was organized in Lunenburg by George Orth. In 1816, Rev Orth succeeded in having a church building erected on a commanding site next to the where our former manse now stands. On July 11, 1816 the frame was raised. On November 16, 1816 the building was finished on the outside, measuring 40' x 32' x 18'. On that same day the first service was held within its walls; hence our church anniversary is held each year in the middle of November but we date our anniversary years from 1814. This year being the 210th!
