BACK “WORDS” #16

History in Plaques/Let There Be Light . . .

When you walk into the sanctuary and look left you see the following stained glass windows on that side of the sanctuary. Window #4 from the front depicts the scene of the Resurrection in Matthew 28:10 – “Then Jesus said unto them, be not afraid.” Window #5 depicts Joseph, Mary and Jesus in the workshop depicting the text from Luke 2:40 – “The child grew strong in spirit. The Grace of God was upon him.” Between those windows are two plaques pertaining to church lighting. One tells us that the electric lighting system was dedicated on March 16, 1930, in memory of Captain R. Scott Corkum by his wife, Mrs. Nettie Corkum. The other tells us that new lighting fixtures were dedicated on November 7, 1974, in memory of J. Henry Wilson Family by Mrs. Amy Butler and the congregation. If you look to the balcony lighting, you see the older version compared to the main floor of the sanctuary. These balcony fixtures are in the style of the original sanctuary lighting.
