Full Time Synod Authorized Minister

A full-time SAM is anyone who works 30 or more hours a week for the congregation/parish, which includes worship, teaching, and other items agreed upon.

When calling a SAM full-time, it is expected that the congregation will pay a salary as well as offer 10% retirement benefits with Portico. Vacation of three weeks, two weeks of sick leave and time alotted for continuing education should also be given. No other benefits are expected but are welcome to be offered.

The salary should be based off of Western North Dakota Synod Guidelines, which can be found on the website or requested from the Synod Office. The expectation is the salary will be in-line with that of a first call pastor at 80%.

EXAMPLE: \$45,000 base salary would be \$36,000 for a SAM. If the congregation/parish would like to offer more, that is also acceptable.

A Synod Authorized Minister should not be seen as an alternative to a Pastor. The congregation/parish is expected to be active in the call process and the SAM is expected to participate in continuing education, and participate in the candidacy process. This includes the SAM submitting a yearly report and the congregation/parish yearly requesting a renewal of their SAM authorization. The yearly renewal comes at the discrection of the candidacy committee, the bishop and the synod council.
