The LYO Board will host a High School Talent Night that will feature our talented gathering participants! A limited number of spots will be available and participants must fill out a form available at the event. All genres of entertainment are encouraged-poetry, song, dance, video, skits, etc. Music and props must be supplied by talent and arranged beforehand with the LYO tech crew.

Friday lunch and dinner will <u>not be</u> provided as part of the gathering.

Any other snacks or pizza that may be ordered in will be at the expense of the individual(s).

#### **POLICIES of the WND LYO Gathering:**

- **A.** <u>Age</u>: Participants must currently be in grades 6-8 for the 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade event and Grades 9-12 for the High School event.
- **B.** <u>7:1 Groups:</u> All participants must register as part of a 7:1 group. For every 7 youth there must be one Adult Advisor, an individual who is at least 21 years of age or employed by the congregation whose youth they are supervising.
- **C.** <u>Male and Female</u> Y<u>outh</u> cannot be in a hotel room together without an adult advisor chaperoning them.
- **D.** THERE IS NO TIME FOR SWIMMING AT LYO. Please make your kids aware as they attend.
- E. All Gathering participants will wear a Gathering Identification Nametag throughout the duration of the Gathering. Entrance to all Gathering events is gained by wearing the nametag.
- **F.** Refunds: \$50 of the \$100 registration will be refunded if requested by October 2, if the request is made in writing to the registrar. (\$50 is non-refundable.) **NO REFUNDS AFTER October 2.**
- **G.** <u>Substitutions</u>: Participant names may be substituted, if done so in writing and submitted to the registrar by October 16<sup>th</sup>.
- H. Hotel Services: Phone calls and room service or other hotel service charges are not included in Gathering registration costs and therefore are the responsibility of the occupants of the rooms and must be paid before checking out. NOTE: Our covenant includes that all Gathering participants will interact with hotel staff in a positive and polite manner, as well as with all other hotel guests.
- I. Adult Leaders: Please plan to participate in the LYO schedule. Adult Leaders are expected to assist LYO Gathering staff and planners, as well as hotel staff, in keeping our youth involved in the scheduled activities, and interacting with their group in a leadership capacity.

#### HOUSING

Standard housing is 4 youth per room and 2 adults per room. You will be asked to organize and indicate the roommate requests for each participant at the time of group online registration. Female youth will stay with other female youth and male youth with other male youth. The only exception is a parent may request to stay with their child.

If you have an odd number of adult advisors, they will be paired up in a room with other adult advisors, unless they wish to cover the \$40 fee for their own room.

If you are traveling with another group, please indicate that in the roommate field on your registration form to assist in making housing assignments.

#### **REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Once you've collected participants registrations, an online registration should be completed by the congregation as a group.

- <u>Please remember</u>, ELCA policy requires a 7:1 ratio of youth per advisor.
- You will be asked to provide room assignments on the registration form. The lodging cost is included in the cost of registration. There will be an additional fee for adults requesting rooms at less than standard occupancy (see housing).
- Please include a T-shirt size for each member of your group.

#### **REGISTRATION FEE:** \$100/person.

- The Registration Deadline is Monday, October 2, with a Final Registration Deadline of October 9, 2023.
- All adult advisors are required to pay the registration fee.

- Parents/Guardians must complete one form per participant
  - ADULT ADVISORS: PLEASE KEEP THESE WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES

#### **HEALTH CONCERNS**

#### JOIN THE HIGH SCHOOL LYO BOARD

The 2023 Board is accepting applications for the role of Vice President and Treasurer of the WND Lutheran Youth Organization, along with Conference Representatives from the East Missouri, Lonetree, Upper Missouri and Turtle Mountain Conferences.

Applications are ONLY open to 9th, 10th, and 11th graders who are youth members of ELCA churches in the Western North Dakota Synod.

Candidates must commit to attending four meetings per year for two years.

#### POSITION DESCRIPTIONS FOR LYO BOARD OFFICERS & CONFERENCE REPRESENTATIVES

#### **Expectations of all LYO Board Officers:**

- Serve a two-year term on the WND Synod LYO Board, attending all meetings of the LYO Board (usually 3 times per year, and the fall gathering)
- Assist in the planning and promotion of the annual WND Synod LYO Gathering.
- Encourage all youth of the synod to grow in their faith and participate in the life of the congregation, synod, and wider church
- Encourage and support all LYO Board members

#### VICE PRESIDENT

The synod LYO vice president serves the first year as vice president then transitions into a second year serving as president of the Western North Dakota Synod LYO Board.

#### **Expectations of the Vice President:**

- Acts in the absence of the president, assuming the responsibilities of the president
- Supports the president by accepting duties and responsibilities assigned.

#### **Expectations of the President:**

- Preside over all meetings of the WND Synod LYO Board and business meetings of the gathering
- Work with Board advisor to prepare agendas for all meetings of the LYO Board
- Represent the WND Synod LYO Board at functions of the synod and the ELCA, such as the Western North Dakota Synod Assembly, synod council meetings, and national gatherings of synod youth organization presidents.
- Submit reports to the WND Synod Assembly and the WND Synod Council.
- Attend the ELCA Youth Leadership Summit during the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of their term.

#### **SECRETARY**

The synod LYO Secretary is elected to a two-year term on the WND Synod LYO Board.

#### **Expectations of the Secretary**

- Report on the financial status of the LYO Board.
- Attend the ELCA Youth Leadership Summit during the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of their term.

#### **CONFERENCE REPRESENTATIVE**

Conference Representatives are elected to a two-year term on the WND Synod LYO Board.

#### **Expectations of Conference Representatives:**

- Communicate with the congregations of their respective conference,
  - o Encourage congregations in their support of youth in ministry in their communities.
  - o Encourage congregations to participate in synod and national youth events.
  - o Promote the annual gathering within their conference.
