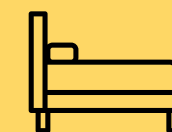

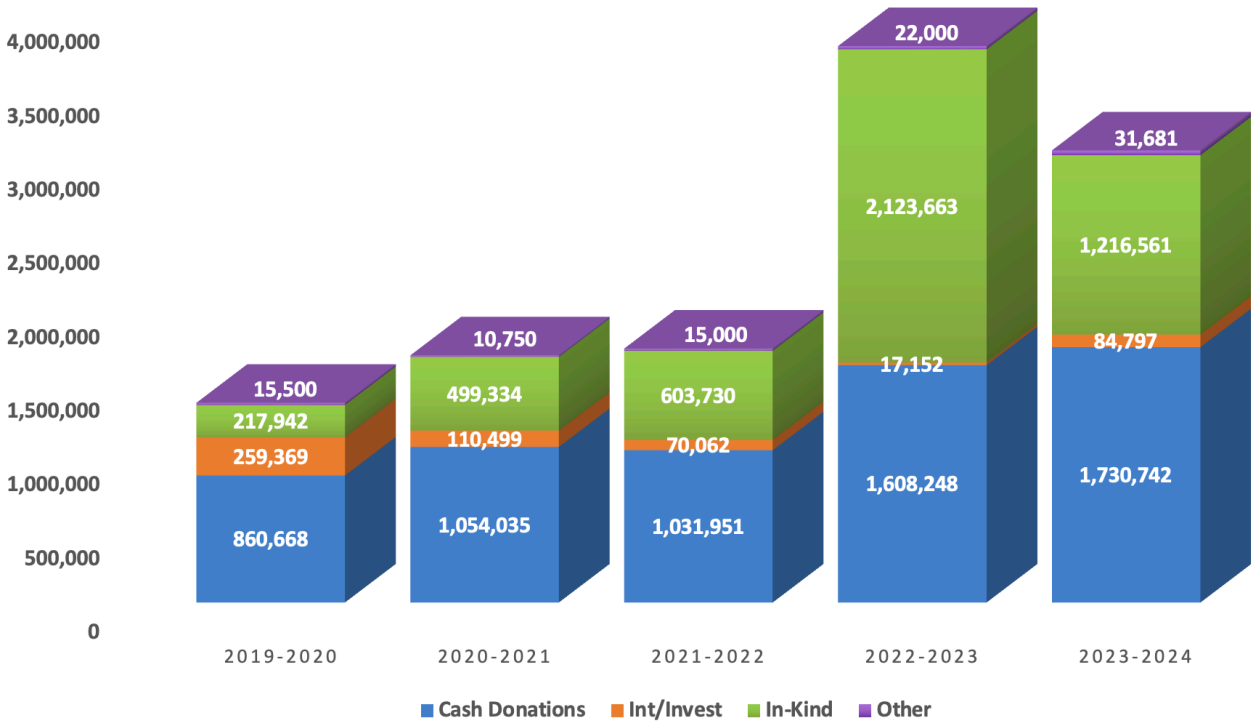

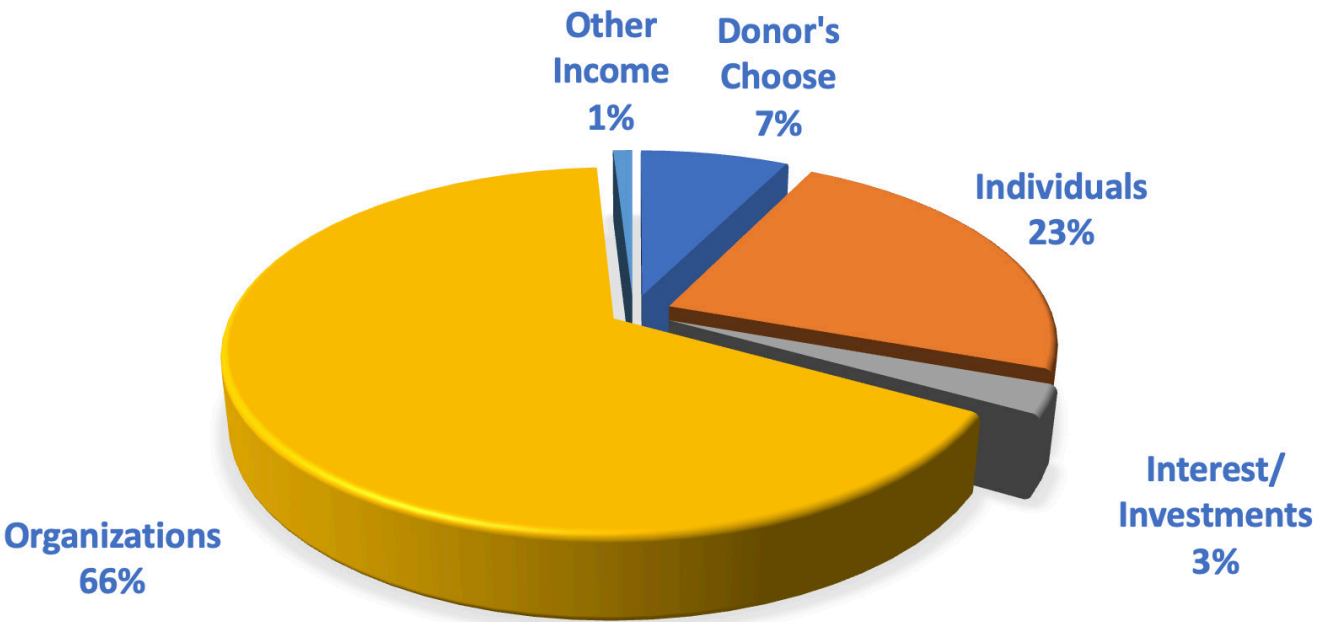

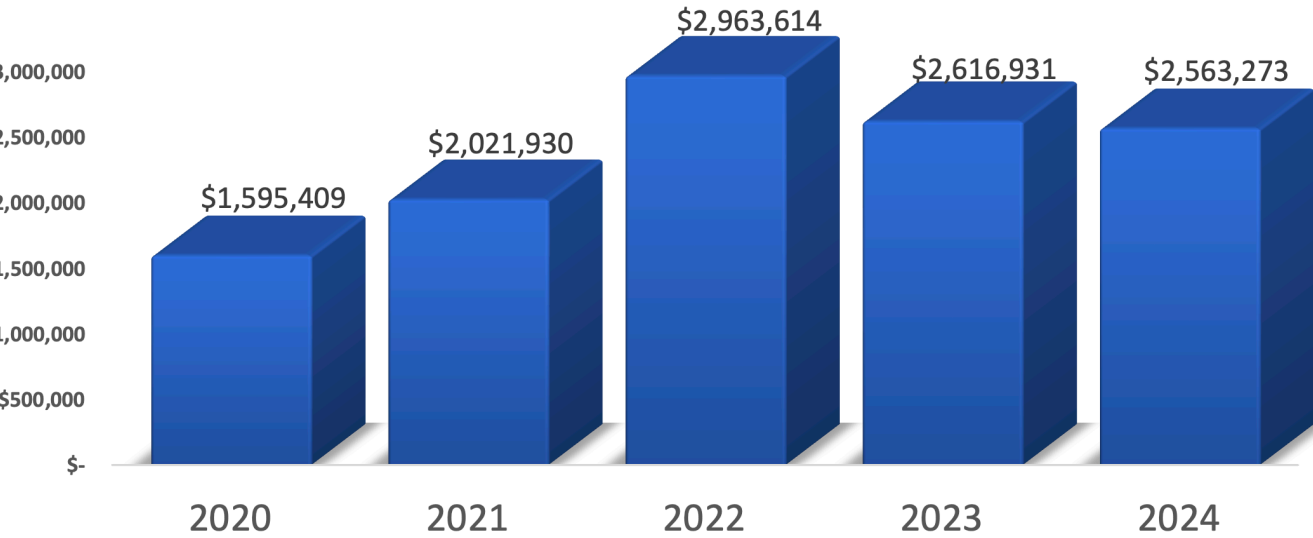
Revenue by Income Type



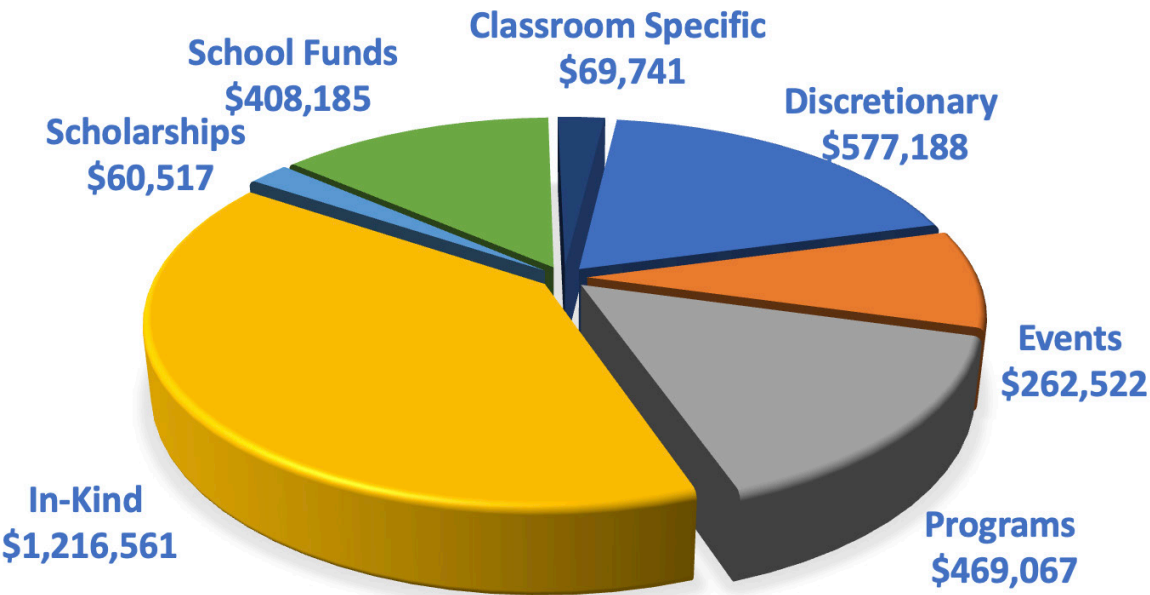
Revenue by Donor Type

The program reduces dramatic outbursts, and teaches life skills such as managing stress and problem solving. Schools with wellness rooms have shown decreases in incidents requiring principal intervention by as much as 90%.

JEF Stories: Lion's Mane



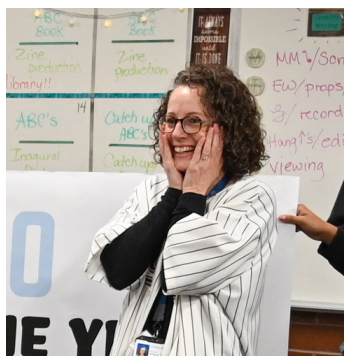

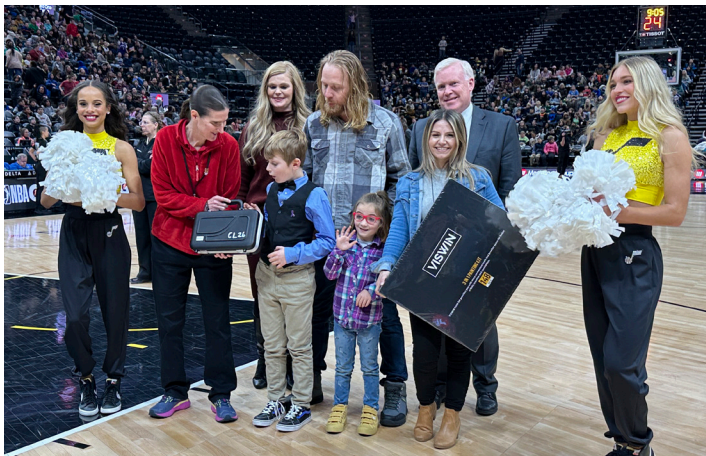
