Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO) Mission to the Archdiocese of Cardiff-Menevia

In line with the recent 'Heart speaks to Heart' Pastoral Message from Archbishop Mark reminding us all that we are called to be a missionary and synodal diocese, Catholic Christian Outreach, known informally as CCO, will be leading a Mission in the Archdiocese from June 19th to July 5th.

CCO are a Catholic Canadian evangelisation team experienced in training people for evangelisation one person at a time. CCO's mission, rooted on university campuses, includes alumni, parishes, dioceses, and other key Church and global partners.

During the Mission a series of events will be taking place, some which are targeted at particular Schools and communities throughout the Archdiocese and some of which are targeted at all parishioners throughout the Archdiocese.

The 'open' events include:

- **Friday, June 19th** from 7pm–10pm – *Nightfever* at Cardiff Cathedral. This is an evening of Adoration, Benediction and Evangelisation in and around the Cathedral. All are welcome to come for as long or as short as you wish, why not bring a friend along with you?
- **Saturday, June 20th** – *Intentional Accompaniment Day* at Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish, Llanelli. This is a day long course introducing parishioners to evangelisation through Intentional Accompaniment – while the venue of this event makes it more convenient for the western half of the Archdiocese, all are welcome, and if you live in the East of the Archdiocese and this date is more convenient for you please go along.
- **Wednesday, June 24th** – *Behold the Lamb of God - A Day of Prayer and Adoration/Holy Hours* across all parishes and schools of the Diocese, offered for the intention of the Mission. Details for local celebrations will be announced shortly.
- **Saturday, June 27th** – *Learning to Pray* at Belmont Abbey. This day of teaching on prayer is led by CCO founder Andre Regnier. The day is open to all who wish to deepen their prayer life.
- **Saturday, July 4th** – *Intentional Accompaniment Day* at Our Lady of the Angels Parish, Cwmbran. This is a day long course introducing parishioners to evangelisation through Intentional Accompaniment. It is a repeat of the event being run in Llanelli on June 20th – all are welcome to attend if they haven't already attended the event on June 20th.

Adoremus 2026 – October 10th

Adoremus is the Bishops' invitation to renew our devotion to the Eucharistic Lord and has two aspects: 1 – A representative gathering of the Church in London with Bishops, priests, and people; 2 – All parishes are encouraged to unite local events with the national gathering from which footage will be available to enable remote participation.

The day begins at St George's Cathedral Southwark. 10.30am Presentations on Eucharistic Art and Life for those able to arrive early, with refreshments available and some information stands around the campus, 12.00 noon The Adoremus Mass, Archbishop John Wilson, followed by keynote address by Cardinal Timothy Radcliffe OP called 'The Eucharist: Our sacrament of hope in dark times'. There will then be time for packed, picnic lunches, before the Eucharistic Procession to Westminster Cathedral of the Most Precious Blood beginning at 3.00pm. This will conclude with Solemn Benediction led by Bishop James Curry at 5pm.

For all there will be space to watch the start of the Procession at St George's, to follow on line, to watch the Procession as it passes (Stop and Pray) and to join the delegates for Benediction either in the Cathedral or the grounds of the Cathedral for which a live sound stream will be provided.

There will then be Mass at 6.00pm open to all, followed by Holy Hours at 7.30pm, 8.30pm, and 9.30pm led by the Youth Ministry teams of Westminster, Southwark and CYMFed. These will be followed by an all-night Vigil from 12 midnight to 06.00am. All of these times can be booked at <https://westminstercathedral.org.uk/adoremus/> to secure places.
