Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have all had a wonderful break and we are all looking forward to brighter evenings and longer days as we approach Spring. We have lots of wonderful things planned for this term. Here are just a few things to bear in mind this term and if you have any further questions please speak with one of the teachers at the end of the day. Please encourage your child to be independent and come into class each morning, hanging up their belongings on their peg in the cloakroom. We will be having morning learning tasks set up in the classroom and we will ask the children to sit down quickly to ensure a smooth transition into their learning.

This term our topic will be 'The Great Fire of London' and we will be focusing on a term of History learning objectives. We will be looking at how the Great Fire of London started and how this affects London today. The children will make Tudor Houses in Forest School out of natural materials and recreate their own of Fire of London at the end of term. We also have Science week at school the week beginning the 9th March. The whole school will be taking part in a trip to Farmer Gow's near Farringdon to carry out a variety of workshops and experiments, details to follow.

We are very grateful for all the parent volunteers who have given some of their time to hear our children read. If you can spare anytime, it would be greatly appreciated and please speak with Mrs Thornton who will add you to the rota. Hearing children read each day, makes such a difference to their learning and we really value the support. Thank you to all those parents and carers who do this daily for their children: telling stories; listening to your child read and sharing stories is an excellent way to improve reading and vocabulary.

Please don't forget to name all your children's clothing (including wellies), water bottles and lunchboxes. As we move into warmer days please make sure the children still have covered arms and legs for forest school, no shorts please. We will sometimes get muddy digging and planting and there are also many stinging nettles!
