## Our Values

# Daily routine

We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. This is very much play based with small group focussed activities taking place throughout the week.

#### Communication

We use Tapestry to record observations from your child's learning. This can be accessed by you and we will help you to get signed up at the Parent's meeting. You can also add your own observations to Tapestry to share "Wow" moments from your child's life.

Please sign up for Parentmail as important letters or information will be emailed via this system. Occasionally, letters will be placed in your child's book bag. If you need to look at copies of letters they can be found by the front door of the school.

At the start of each term we send out a knowledge organiser with our curriculum and any important dates for that term.

#### Clothing

Children need wellies and a waterproof coat in school every day. In the Summer, they will also need a sun hat as we spend some time outside every day. Please also provide a spare set of clothes, including underwear and socks, in case of accidents.

Please make sure that all your child's clothing is clearly named!

#### Book bag

Your child needs to bring their book bag to school every day with their reading book and reading record in it.

#### Forest school

Forest School is an important part of our curriculum. Further details will be sent in due course.

#### Snack and lunch

All children in reception and KS1 are entitled to a free school lunch, which needs to be booked in advance via Parentmail (lunch menus can be found on the school website). Alternatively, if your child does not wish to have a free meal, you can send them in with a packed lunch. They are also provided with fruit as a snack, free milk daily up until they reach their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday and have access to fresh water all day.

School starts at 8.40am and finishes at 3.10pm. The gates are opened each morning at 8.40am.

# Breakfast Club and Pitstop Afterschool Club

Breakfast Club runs from 8.00am until 8.40am Monday to Friday. The present cost of this is £6 per session.

Pitstop Afterschool club runs from 3.10pm until 5.30pm Monday to Friday. There are two sessions, 3.10pm until 4.45pm which costs £7 per session or 3.10pm - 5.30pm which costs £10.
