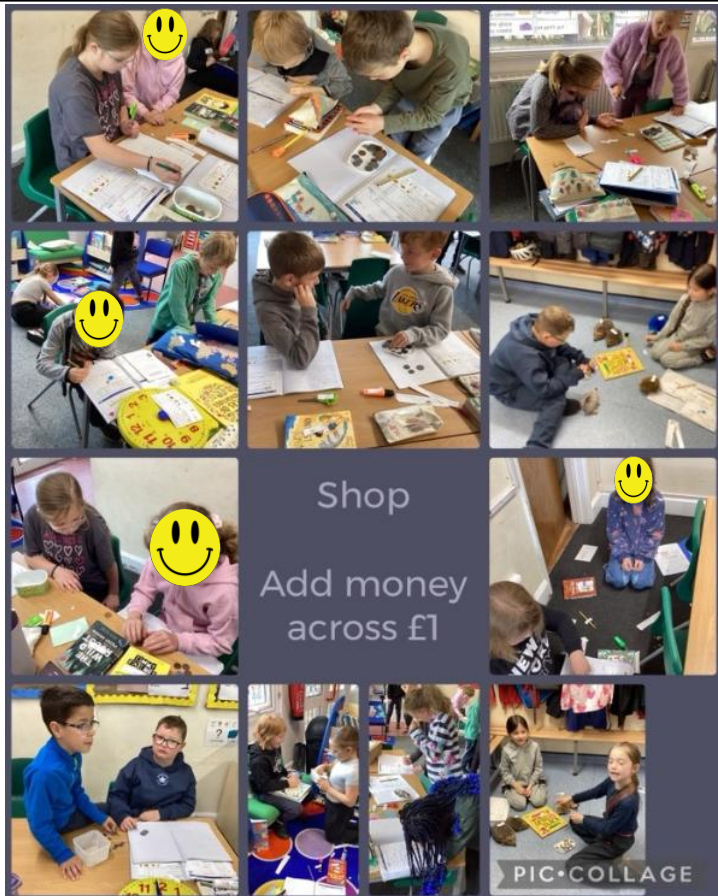


Our planters and wild flower bed are enjoying the changeable weather and all the children are discovering the wonderful world of gardening.
