

Badger Class: Winter Wonderland

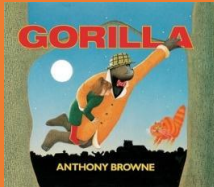
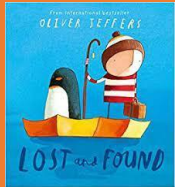
Previous learning:

Key Facts:

- There are 7 continents: Europe, North America, South America, Asia, Africa, Antarctica and Australasia.
- Climate change is effecting our weather
- It rains for more than 156 days a year in the UK.
