- **Status of Women Committee** to support women through community involvement for women facing hardships including but not limited to economic and domestic.
- Masquerade Gala **Committee** to assist in the planning of our largest fundraiser of the year, All members should assume that they are part of the planning and implementing of the various activities to raise money for our Scholarship Fund.
- **Programming Committee** to plan and implement a well-coordinated program calendar, choosing topics and guest speakers for our monthly business meetings.
- Public Relations to market the club through available news media, the Club website and newsletter and social media.
- **Youth Leadership Committee** to encourage recruitment of young people into membership; organize and coordinate youth leadership programs; and promote activities that involve the participation of young people.
- Scholarship Committee to allocate scholarship funds which have been authorized by the board.
