WHAT IS THE PURPOSE?

To empower children to participate in Mass as fully as possible! During C.L.O.W., the Scripture readings of the Mass are broken open and explained on a level young students can understand; thereby helping them grow in their love and understanding of God!

How does C.L.O.W. work?

Mass begins as usual. Then just before the First Reading, the children are invited to go with a group of adult leaders to Kelley Hall. During this time, the children are led through a Liturgy of the Word with readings, a reflection, Creed and petitions all on their level! Students return to the Church after the Intercessions.

- A part of the Mass
- Focused on the Word of God
- A form of worship
- A form of prayer

No registration necessary! Parents and families may accompany their children if they wish! It is a part of the Mass, so it still counts toward your Sunday obligation!
