PROGRAM OVERVIEW

LPU Online's Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Management will provide you with the practical skills you need to be an effective leader in any organization and a strong biblical foundation to make a difference for the kingdom wherever you are. Students in the Immersive Training Program will combine our online education with practical experience and pastoral mentoring in their local ministry contexts.

FORMAT & SCHEDULE

The online bachelor's program is a 4-year program which students can begin in either the fall or spring. Each semester is divided into two 8-week sessions with two classes per session and one 16-week ministry practicum/ immersive training course that stretches across the entire semester. In addition to weekly reading and assignments, students will engage in their community through various ministry opportunities at their Immersive Training location. Students enrolled in a full-time course load should expect to spend an average of 12-15 hours per week on coursework for each class.
