PROGRAM OVERVIEW

LPU's BA in Psychology offers a multidisciplinary perspective on human behavior and development with biblical integration, preparing students for careers in the helping professions. Upon graduation, students can obtain jobs in social service agencies, working with children and adults in their communities, or pursue graduate degrees in fields such as social work, marriage and family therapy, professional counseling, and educational and psychological services. Every student gains real-world experience through an internship, applying their learning in practical settings.

The degree includes a Biblical Studies minor, with faith integration woven throughout each course to equip students as professionals who advance God's kingdom. Most importantly, our program is Christ-centered and Spirit-filled, empowering students to approach their work and calling with purpose, compassion, and reliance on the guidance of the Holy Spirit. This strong foundation uniquely prepares graduates to serve their communities with excellence, faith, and a transformative impact.

FORMAT & SCHEDULE

The online bachelor's program is a 4-year program which students can begin in either the fall or spring. Each semester is divided into two 8-week sessions with two classes per session and one 16-week ministry practicum/ immersive training course that stretches across the entire semester. In addition to weekly reading and assignments, students will engage in their community through various ministry opportunities at their Immersive Training location. Students enrolled in a full-time course load should expect to spend an average of 12-15 hours per week on coursework for each class.

This program is a great fit for students of all ages with varied experience. No prior college is needed for this fully online B.A. However, this program is very transfer-friendly allowing students the ability to transfer up to 72 units!
