

Wiregrass Blues Festival Gumbo Cook-Off

OFFICIAL RULES & ENTRY FORM

All teams must be registered by 10:00 AM.
Samples will be collected for judging at 2:00 PM.

Only one gumbo entry per team is allowed.
Gumbo must be cooked on site.

Categories

Chicken & Sausage Gumbo – No seafood allowed.
Seafood Gumbo – Seafood must be the primary protein.

Judges' samples must contain juice and meat only — no rice.
Two pint containers will be provided for judging.

Judging Criteria

Appearance, Flavor, Meat (seasoning/tenderness), Overall.

Awards

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category.
Battle for the Paddle – Best Overall Gumbo.

Entry Fee: \$50

Additional Rules

Public sampling begins after judges' samples are collected at 2:00 PM.
Teams must serve until 4:00 PM or festival close.
Awards announced at 5:30 PM.

Cooking Requirements

No setup prior to 10:00 AM.
Teams limited to 4 members.
Minimum of 10 gallons of gumbo required.
Roux must be cooked on site.

General Guidelines

No alcohol may be sold.
Safety and sanitation rules must be followed.
Violations may result in disqualification.
