INTRODUCTION

Responsibilities

Management

- o Ensure the availability of appropriate PPE.
- Conduct regular hazard assessments.
- Provide necessary training on PPE usage.
- o Monitor compliance and address non-compliance promptly.

Employees

- Utilize PPE as instructed.
- Report any damaged or defective PPE.
- Participate in training sessions.
- o Comply with all safety protocols.

PPE Selection and Use

Hazard Assessment

- Conduct thorough assessments to identify potential hazards.
- Document findings and determine appropriate PPE for each task.

PPE Types and Usage

1. Gloves

Protect hands from chemicals, cuts, and abrasions. Types include latex, nitrile, and vinyl gloves, each suited for specific tasks.



2. Face Masks and Respirators

Protect against inhaling airborne particles and hazardous fumes. Options include disposable surgical masks, N95 respirators, and full-face shield masks.



3. Goggles and Safety Glasses

Shield eyes from splashes of cleaning chemicals and reduce the risk of touching eyes with contaminated hands.



4. Face Shields

Provide additional protection for the face from splashes and airborne particles.



5. Protective Clothing

Includes aprons, coveralls, and foot coverings to protect the skin from direct contact with harmful chemicals and contaminants.



6. Hearing Protection:

Earplugs and earmuffs to protect against noise hazards.



7. High-Visibility Clothing:

Ensure workers are easily seen in low-light conditions.



8. Safety Helmets:

Protect the head from potential impacts.



9. Disposable Overshoes:

Prevent cross-contamination between different areas of a facility.



10. Chemical-Resistant Boots:

Provide foot protection from chemical spills and slips.



Usage Guidelines

- a. Follow manufacturer instructions for each type of PPE.
- b. Ensure proper fit and adjust as needed.
- c. Replace damaged or worn-out PPE immediately.

Training and Education

• Training Programs

Inspection, Maintenance, and Replacement
