St. John the Apostle Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Welcome to the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Registration! The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a Montessori-based method of spiritual and religious formation for children, founded in Rome in 1954. This approach follows the teaching of St. Thomas Aquinas that all of our knowledge has its origin in the senses. Children are given developmentally appropriate presentations and sensorial materials with which to explore the life of Jesus, the Scripture and the Sacraments. These materials include—among many others—figures of Jesus and the Apostles during the Last Supper, a model altar, a model baptismal font and a raised-surface map of the land of Israel. This concrete way of presenting the faith mirrors the way the Church teaches us throughout our lives, by means of the sacraments, holy water and oils, incense, sacred art and statues.

The "atrium" is a room specially prepared for our children to grow in their relationship with Jesus. It is a place of prayer. CGS is not a program or a class with a textbook curriculum as in a traditional setting, but rather a shared religious experience with children and adults. They will grow in their knowledge of the life of Jesus and the land of Israel, and of their Catholic faith through reflecting on passages from the Bible and learning about the Mass and the Sacraments. The children will also learn to choose appropriate works and to concentrate as they work, to contemplate the religious themes, then restore their work for the next person.

CGS catechists are trained to serve the children in humility knowing that the true teacher is the Holy Spirit. They receive 90 hours of formation for each age level that they serve. Both the prepared adult and the prepared environment are key to this approach.

ATRIUM SESSIONS FOR 2025-2026 CGS is offered on a first come first serve basis, with preference given to families who have previously participated. Registration date will be noted. When a session is full, the child will be placed on a waitlist. Notification of acceptance into an atrium will be sent by email.
