ANSWER TO ORGAN QUESTION: Yes, the celeste rank(s) a stop or a family of stops tuned slightly sharp (or flat) to give a "heavenly", "celestial" or an undulating effect. The celeste is usually created on the string stops (sounds). We have one celeste set of two ranks called an Aeolian from the 1910 Estey organ, but it is not currently working.

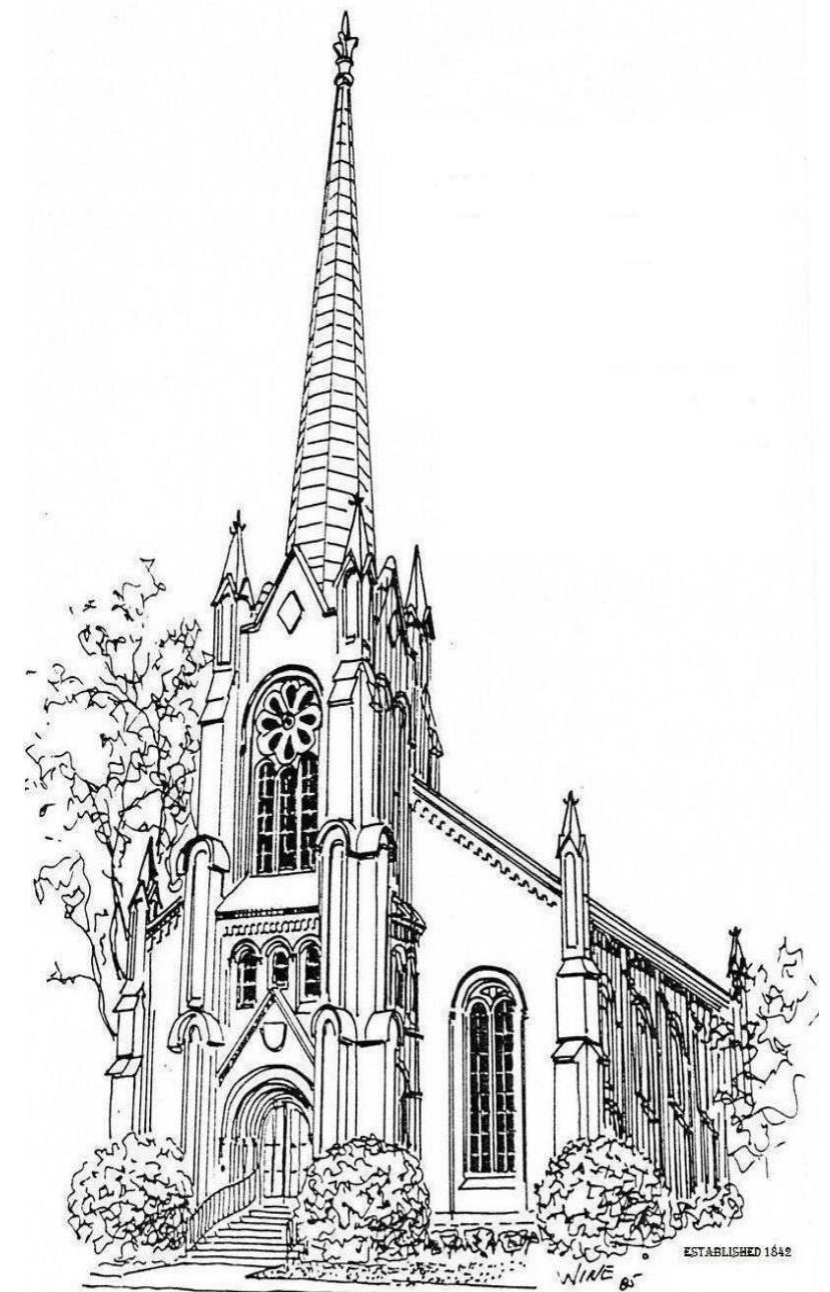
