PATH BUILDING FUNDRAISER

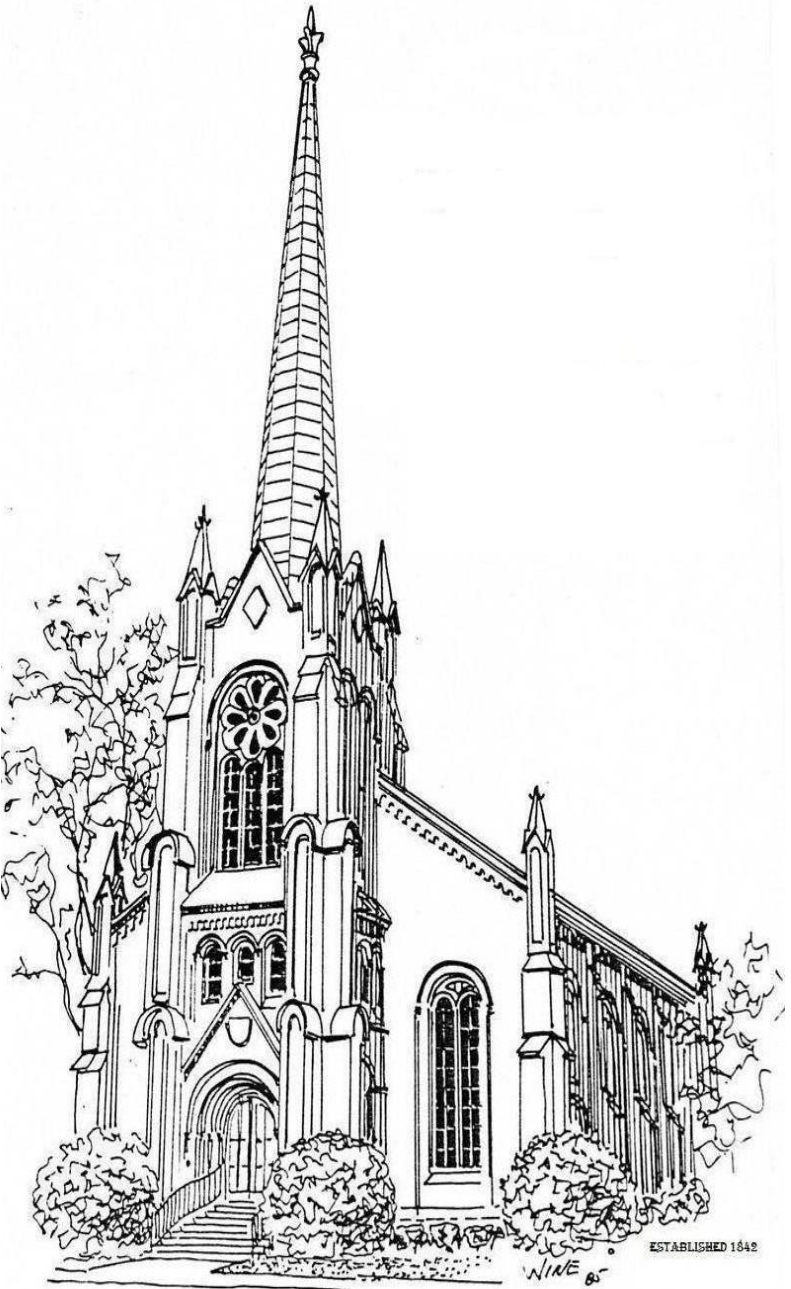
