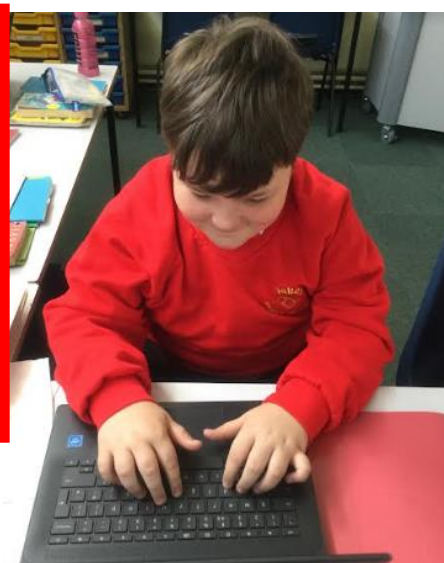


## A view into Valley...
