### Mobile phones in school:



Could we remind parents/carers not to bring mobile phones into school during visits/school events/assemblies. There were several being used/out on show today which we do not allow for safeguarding purposes. If you must bring your phone with you, please keep it stored away in a bag/pocket and do not take it out whilst inside the school. You are welcome to use your phone outside the front of school if you need to take or make an urgent phone call.

### Parking:



Unfortunately, we have had further complaints regarding parking around the school. There are now double yellow lines on parts of Owls End, as well as yellow zig zag lines. Stopping or parking is prohibited in these areas and they are in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians, particularly children near schools, and to maintain clear access for emergency vehicles. Stopping or parking on double yellow lines is not allowed at any time.

Please, parents/carers, when you are bringing your children to school or collecting them, **do not** park on these yellow lines.

We have also been informed that some parents/carers have been parking next to the corner of Owls End/Brookfield Way. Please avoid this – it can cause obstruction and is dangerous.

### OPAL:



Thank you for the donations we have received so far for our OPAL (playground) project. We are very excited that we are able to introduce this to the children next week. More involved use of the project will take place from September.

### Y6 Production:



We are all looking forward to the Y6 production of Pirates of the Curry Bean next week. This will be taking place on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July (2pm) and Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July (10am). Seating will be available on a first come first served basis (no tickets) but we would ask that you restrict your numbers to a maximum of three people (per child) per performance.
